

Recent Update:

A firm tone was witnessed in Sugar physical markets today in India. Sugar prices were lower in Delhi by Rs.10-20 at Rs. 3480/q. Prices were higher in Kolhapur at Rs. 3200/q.

Punjab government has increased the State Advised Price for sugarcane. The government has increased the State Advised Price for sugarcane by Rs. 15 per quintal for the crushing season 2021-22. The early variety of sugarcane will now cost Rs. 325 per quintal as against Rs. 310 per quintal earlier while the mid-variety cane price will increase from Rs. 300 to Rs. 315 per quintal. The late maturing price has increased from Rs. 295 to Rs. 310 per quintal. As per the government estimate, around 660 lakh quintals of sugarcane would be crushed in the state during 2021-22 crushing season.

Previous Updates:

Indian Sugar Industry is expecting a good export season. As the world sugar prices are bullish Indian sugar industry is expecting a good run in the overseas market in the coming 2021-22 season. According to Indian Sugar Mills Association, if the current raw sugar prices hold or rise, then India would end up exporting around 30-60 lakh tonnes of sugar in the coming season.

Sugarcane farmers from Punjab may launch a protest on 20th August 2021. According to the market sources, Punjab sugarcane farmers may launch protest as the sugar mills had not yet cleared their pending cane dues. The sugar mills including private and cooperative owe arrears worth Rs. 200 crore from the last crushing season. The private mills owe Rs. 145 crore and cooperative mills Rs. 55 crore.

Indian Sugar Mills Association has urged the government to increase the minimum selling price of sugar. ISMA has urged the government to immediately increase the MSP of sugar from the current Rs. 31 per kg to at least Rs. 34-35 per kg. According to ISMA this will not only improve the revenue realization of sugar mills from sale of sugar but also will help in clearing the cane arrears of the farmers. Minimum selling price was last increased in 2019.

Domestic sugar prices have increased up by Rs.300-400 per quintal in the last two weeks of August 2021. With the dawn of 'Shravan' month which brings in many auspicious days and prominent festivals across India and easing of state-wise lockdown across the country. The market has changed drastically and the country has started witnessing aggressive demand. Within the first 15 days of the announcement of August month sugar sales quota, sugar sales accounted for over 75 to 80 percent of the quota sale in Maharashtra and roughly 70-75 percent in Uttar Pradesh, leading to supply tightness in the market.

Area under sugarcane has increased in Purvanchal. According to the government officials, area under sugarcane has increased by 1.34 lakh hectares in the past four years, the cane cultivation in Purvanchal has been 4.39 lakh hectares which has increased to 5.37 lakh hectares. Farmer's income has also increased by Rs. 22,000 per hectares. The Average yield of sugarcane has also improved to 722 quintals per hectare from 652.72 quintals per hectare as compared to the past 4 years.

According to the Ministry of Agriculture advance estimate for 2020-21 season. Total production of Sugarcane during 2020-21 season is estimated at 399.25 million tonnes. The production of sugarcane during 2020-21 is higher by 37.18 million tonnes than the average sugarcane production of 362.07 million tonnes.

Sugarcane farmers from Saharanpur are demanding hike in sugarcane price. Sugarcane farmers under the banner of Bhartiya Kisan Sangh have demanded a hike in the sugarcane purchase price to Rs 400 per quintal. The farmers also demanded clearance of the cane dues of the previous crushing season with interest on it.

Around 250 sugar mills are non operational in India. According to the Minister of State and Rural Development, around 250 sugar mills are closed in India due to financial crunch and poor recovery from sugarcane. The highest numbers of closed sugar mill are from Maharashtra followed by Karnataka and Uttar Pradesh.

Brazil Sugar Production may fall to 32.5 million tonnes in 2021-22 season. Sugar production in the center-south region of Brazil is likely to fall to 32.5 million tonnes from an earlier estimate of 34.1 million tonnes due to drought and frost. Also, this provides opportunities for India to export raw sugar.

Sugarcane crop in Haryana get affected due to pest attack. The Top Borer has affected the sugarcane crop in Yamunanagar, Karnal and Kurukshetra districts. Pest attack has currently been observed in Co-0238 variety of sugarcane. The farmers have grown CO 0238 variety of sugarcane in over 40 percent of the area, farmers are spending on pesticides to protect their crop.
