

Sugar & Gur Daily Fundamental Report

13th Jan, 2022

Recent Update:

A firmtone was witnessed in Sugar physical markets today in India. Sugar prices were higher in Delhi by Rs.20-40 at Rs. 3430/q. Prices were in Kolhapur was at Rs. 3200/q.

Rajasthan government has approved the hike of Rs 50 per quintal hike in the purchase price of sugarcane by Rajasthan State Ganganagar Sugar Mills (RSGSM) for the crushing season 2021-22. The government has approved the purchase price of the early variety of sugarcane at Rs 360 per quintal, the rate for medium grade sugarcane will be Rs 350 per quintal and the late variety sugarcane will be purchased at Rs 345 per quintal.

Weather Forecast:

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightening & hail at isolated places very likely over Odisha and with lightening at isolated places over Vidarbha, Chattisgarh, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Telangana. Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Odisha and Telanagna.

Previous Updates:

According to the Maharashtra sugar commissioner, Sugar mills in Maharashtra have produced 536.89 lakh quintals of sugar till 09th January 2022 by crushing 547.09 lakh tonnes of sugarcane. Around 190 sugar mills are currently participating in the cane crushing operation in Maharashtra.

The sugar mills from the Pune region have achieved 10.01 per cent recovery rate. The mills have produced 112.19 lakh quintal sugar by crushing 112.11 lakh tonne sugarcane till 09th January, 2022. Total 29 sugar mills are operating in the region. Kolhapur division is leading in the state in terms of sugar production and has achieved a recovery rate of 11.15 percent.

Nepal government has increased the minimum support price of sugarcane by 8.39 percent as compared to previous season. The government has increased the minimum support price of sugarcane for the ongoing crushing season by 8.39% to Rs 590 per quintal. The MSP during the last season was Rs. 544.33 per quintal. The crushing season has begun in November last year.

Bangladesh sugar mills are likely to produce less sugar this season. The two sugar mills located in Thakurgaon and Joypurhat are likely to produce less sugar this season as they have lowered the volume of sugarcane crushing due to technical glitches. The mills are expected to crush around 50,000 to 30,000 tonnes of sugarcane this season. The suspension of operations of six sugar mills has affected the farmers from Dinajpur, Thakurgaon, Natore, Rangpur, Gaibandha, Pabna and Panchagarh since 2020.

For the 2021-22 season, the Government has set a target to achieve 10% blending across the country in the current year. Against a total requirement of 459 crore ltrs of ethanol for 10% blending, Oil Marketing Companies have so far allocated a total of 366 crore ltrs after first two cycles of EOI, i.e. 317 Crore ltr against offer of 414 Crore ltr in 1st cycle of EOI and 49 Crore ltrs against an offer of 82 Crore ltrs in 2nd cycle of EOI. Further, OMCs had floated the 3rd EOI indicating requirement of about 94 Crore liters on 25th December,



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2021, for which about 30 Crore liters of offers have been received by them. Currently, OMCs are examining the bids and are expected to make the allocations in a few days' time.
