

**Recent Update:**

**A steady tone witnessed in Sugar physical markets today in India.** Sugar prices were higher in Delhi at Rs. 3390/qrtl and in Kolhapur market prices were steady at Rs. 3250/qrtl.

Sugarcane crushing season in Uttar Pradesh has entered the final phase as several mills are closing their operations. As on 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2022, sugar mills have produced 84.06 lakh tonnes of sugar by crushing 833.60 lakh tonnes of sugarcane and they have so far cleared Rs 18,647.83 crore cane payment which is around 71.28 per cent. Earlier, the mills have made almost 100 percent of the payment for the previous seasons. The amount cleared for the 2020-21 season is around Rs 32,872.28 crore which is 99.57% of the total dues. For the 2021-22 season, the state government is taking steps to ensure that the sugar mills will make 100 per cent cane payment.

**Weather Forecast:**

Heat wave to severe heat wave conditions in isolated pockets over West Rajasthan. Heat wave conditions very likely at some places over East Rajasthan and in isolated places over South Haryana & Delhi, south Uttar Pradesh, Saurashtra & kutch, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Jharkhand, Odisha, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada. Thunderstorm accompanied with lightening very likely at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland- Manipur- Mizoram, Tripura, Arunachal Pradesh and with lighting at isolated places over Sub- Himalaya West Bengal & Sikkim and Kerala -Mahe is also expected.

**Previous Updates:**

During the 2021-22 ethanol supply year, about 113 crore litres of ethanol have been blended with petrol in India till 13<sup>th</sup> March 2022, thereby achieving 9.45 percent blending across. The government is confident for achieving 10 percent blending rate in the 2021-22 season. Earlier the government has fixed 20 percent blending target till 2025. During the 2021-22 season, Telangana leads in Ethanol Blending with Petrol programme with 10.57 percent blending rate, followed by Karnataka with 10.37 percent.

According to the Thai Sugar Millers Corporation, the sugar output in Thailand is likely to reach 10 million tonne by 31<sup>st</sup> March 22. After two years of low output, sugar production in Thailand is likely to increase in the current season over good yield following favorable weather. The sugar mills have produced 9.6 million tonne of sugar by crushing 87.75 million tonne of cane so far. The sugar output in the last season was 6.7 million tonne and, in this season, it is expected to rise by 35% to 90 million tonnes.

Uttar Pradesh is likely to witness low sugar production in the current 2021-22 season as compared to the previous season. The diversion of sugar to ethanol production and the rising disease and pest infestation are the major reasons for the declined sugar output. Indian Sugar Mills Association has earlier estimated sugar production in UP to be 102 lakh tonne as against 110.59 lakh tonne in last year.
