### **Recent Update:**

**Sugar physical market showed a mixed trend today in India.** Sugar prices were higher in Delhi market at Rs. 3500/qtl and in Kolhapur market prices were higher at Rs. 3350/qtl.

Bangladesh Sugar and Food Industries Corporation has fixed the maximum retail price of sugar at Bangladeshi Taka (BT) TK85 per kgs. The sugar is however sold at shops at the hiked rate of Tk100-120. BSFIC although has threatened to initiate action against those traders and businesses responsible for hiking sugar prices across the country.

### **Weather Forecast:**

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightening winds & hail is very likely at isolated places over Uttarakhand and with lightening & gusty winds at isolated places over East Rajasthan, East Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand, and with lightening at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Chattisgarh, Gangetic West Bengal, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, Tripura, Assam & Meghalaya, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry & Karaikal, Lakshadweep, Kerala & Mahe.

### **Previous Updates:**

According to Unica, the sugarcane crushing in May'22 has reached 34.37 million tonnes, down by 17 percent as compared to previous season. Sugar production has reached 1.67 million tonnes and around 1.58 billion litres of ethanol has been produced which is further down by 10 percent as compared to the previous season. The sugarcane crushing season although has picked up pace but still remains delayed from previous year.

The Central government has imposed restrictions on sugar exports up to 100 lakhs metric tonnes (LMT) from 01<sup>st</sup> June, 2022, to maintain domestic availability and price stability during the sugar season 2021-22. The Ministry of Commerce and Industry has issued an order on 24<sup>th</sup> May 2022 with effect from 01<sup>st</sup> June 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022, as per that the export of the sugar will be allowed with specific permission of the Directorate of Sugar, Department of Food and Public Distribution. This restriction is not applicable to sugar being exported to EU and USA under CXL and TRQ quota. The Department has given the order to maintain domestic availability of sugar in the country and to maintain the price stability.

With rising food scarcity in some regions of Pakistan, the government had imposed a complete ban on the export of sugar to stabilize the prices in the domestic market. Despite the record sugar production in 2021-22 season, the Consumers in Pakistan have been complaining about the shortage of sugar. The shortage was particularly reported in Punjab, where utility stores had run out of sugar. Sugar prices are currently ranging between Rs. 90 - 102 per kgs.
