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Sugar Fundamental Report

Recent Update:

Sugar physical market showed a mixed trend today in India. Sugar prices were higher in Delhi market at Rs. 3520/qtl and in Kolhapur market prices were higher at Rs. 3340/qtl.

The National Federation of Cooperative Sugar Factories has estimated domestic sugar production to be at 35.24 million tonnes in the 2021-22 season which is around 15 percent higher as compared to the previous season. The sugar production is estimated to increase in Maharashtra at 13.68 MT against the 10.63 MT previous year and in Karnataka to increase at 5.92 MT as compared to the previous season 4.25 MT. Sugar production in Uttar Pradesh was lower in the 2021-22 season at 10.22 MT as compared to the previous season 11.01 MT.

Weather Forecast:

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightening & winds is very likely at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, and with lightening & gusty winds at isolated places over Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Rayalaseema, and with lightening at isolated places over Bihar, Sub- Himalayan West Bengal, Sikkim, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, Tripura, Madhya Maharashtra, Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry & Karaikal, Lakshadweep.

Previous Updates:

GoI has allotted the monthly sugar sale quota of 21 lakh MT for the month of June which is 1 lakh MT lower from previous year. Consideration of lower sale quota is mainly due to expectation of lower demand with the coming monsoon season.

India is expected to export around 9-10 million tonnes of sugar in the 2021-22 season against the previous season of 7.2 million tonnes of sugar. The lower production in Brazil has increased the demand of Indian Sugar in the international market.

The sugarcane crushing season in Maharashtra has entered its last stage. Around 10 lakh tonnes of cane are still remaining to be crushed in the state. Sugar mills in Maharashtra had crushed 1,312 lakh tonnes of cane with 146 out of 200 mills which had ended crushing this season. Districts of Jalna, Osmanabad, and Solapur had reported the most acres of unharvested cane. During the 2021-22 season sugarcane production in Maharashtra has increased comparatively because of increase in area and good yield. Yield has improved from 80 to 120 tonnes per hectares. As per the market sources, sugar production is expected to be 138 lakh tonnes in the 2021-22 season.
