### **Sugar Fundamental Report**

05<sup>th</sup> July, 2022

#### **Recent Update:**

**Sugar physical market showed a mixed trend today in India.** Sugar prices were lower in Delhi market at Rs. 3490/qtl whereas in Kolhapur market prices were stable at Rs. 3350/qtl.

Sugarcane area in Uttar Pradesh is expected to increase in the coming 2022-23 season. As per the market sources, area is expected to increase in over 50,000 hectares as compared to last year. The productivity of the sugarcane crop has increased to 823 quintals per hectare this year as compared to 815 quintals per hectare last year.

#### Weather Forecast:

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightening & gusty winds is very likely at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands and thunderstorm accompanied with lightening at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan, & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Rajasthan, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Odisha, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Meghalaya & Tripura, Gujarat State, West Madhya Pradesh, Madhya Maharashtra, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, and Interior Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe. Heavy rainfall at isolated places East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Konkan & Goa, Coastal Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe, and heavy rainfall at isolated places over Jammu , Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan, Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Rajasthan, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Odisha, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Meghalaya & Tripura, Gujarat State, West Madhya Pradesh, Madhya Maharashtra, Costal Andhra Pradesh, & Yanam, Telangana, Interior Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry, Karaikal.

#### Previous Updates:

According to Unica, Brazil's Center South region sugarcane crushing in first half of June'22 has reached 38.6 million tonnes, higher by 5.76 percent as compared to the previous season. Sugar production has reached 2.14 million tonnes so far. However, Sugarcane crushing was bit affected in Brazil due to adverse weather conditions in June 2022.

Sugarcane crushing is almost over in the country for the 2021-22 season. The 2021-22 season is also the year of longest crushing season, as the mills operated for 240 days. Maharashtra has again led the country in terms of sugar production with 138 lakh tonnes of sugar produced during 2021-22 season. Although, Sugarcane Crushing (Special) season in Tamil Nadu and Karnataka will commence from July 2022

GoI has allotted the monthly sugar sale quota of 21 lakh MT for the month of July'2022 which is 1 lakh MT lower from previous year. Consideration of lower sale quota is mainly due to expectation of lower demand with the coming monsoon season. In the previous month (June) government allotted 21 lakh MT of monthly sugar sales quota.
