Recent Update:

Sugar physical market showed a mixed trend today in India. Sugar prices were slightly lower in the Delhi market at Rs. 3420/qtl whereas in the Kolhapur market prices were at Rs. 3325/qtl.

As of 12th July 2022, Rajasthan Sugarcane sowing has reached 4.00 hectares for the 2022-23 season which is slightly higher compared to the previous season's sowing of 3.80 hectares.

Previous Updates:

With the progress of the monsoon over the southern, central, and western regions Kharif sowing has increased in the country for the 2022-23 season. According to the data released by Agriculture Ministry, Kharif crops have been sown in 40.66 million hectares which is about 9 percent less than the corresponding period last year. Sugarcane sowing has been reported at 53.31 lakh hectares which were 53.55 lakh hectares in the previous 2021-22 season as of 08th July 2022.

Sugar mills in Uttar Pradesh have cleared Rs.28,787.80 crore of cane dues which is 81.78 percent of the total cane dues. Sugar mills in Uttar Pradesh have produced 102.48 lakh tonnes of sugar by crushing 1014.76 lakh tonnes of sugarcane. Also, Sugarcane crushing is already over for the 2021-22 season in Uttar Pradesh.

The Department of Food & Public Distribution has revised the monthly sugar quota allocated for domestic sales in July 2022. The quota has been revised and increased by 44,962 MT summing to 21.44LMT. Earlier, the allocated sugar sales quota was 21 LMT.

As of 29th July 2022, Andhra Pradesh sugarcane sowing has reached 0.19 lakh hectares for the 2022-23 season which is slightly lower compared to the previous season's sowing of 0.18 lakh hectares. Cumulative rainfall as of 29th July has reached 201707 mm lower as compared to the previous season of 217034 mm.
