

# **Sugar Fundamental Report**

02<sup>nd</sup> Aug, 2022

### **Recent Update:**

**Sugar physical market showed a mixed trend today in India.** Sugar prices were stable in the Delhi market at Rs. 3440/qtl whereas in the Kolhapur market prices were stable at Rs. 3300/qtl.

Sugar Exports are currently under restricted category. In June'2022, the government has capped sugar exports at 10 million tonnes. Mills have exported 9.97 MT of sugar so far in the ongoing 2021-22 season to countries such as Nepal, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, UAE, Afghanistan, Indonesia, Somalia etc. However, as per the market sources the Centre is likely to allow an additional 1.2 million tonnes (MT) of sugar exports in the 2021-22 season ending September 2022 taking into account higher-than-anticipated domestic production.

### **Weather Forecast**

Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Kerala & Mahe, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry, Karaikal, and heavy rainfall at isolated places over Coastal & South Interior Karnataka, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, Bihar, Sub-Himalayan, West Bengal, Odisha, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, North Interior Karnataka, Lakshadweep. Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds likely at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, and with lightening at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, North Interior Karnataka, Lakshadweep.

### **Previous Updates:**

According to the data released by Agriculture Ministry, as of 29<sup>th</sup> July 2022, Sugarcane sowing has been reported at 54.41 lakh hectares which was 55.83 lakh hectares in the previous 2021-22 season.

According to Unica, Brazil's Center South region sugarcane crushing in the first half of July'22 has reached 46.34 million tonnes higher as compared to the previous season by 0.48 percent. Sugar production has reached 2.97 million tonnes in the first half of July 2022.

As of 27<sup>th</sup> July 2022, Telangana Sugarcane sowing has reached 22312 acres for the 2022-23 season which is slightly lower compared to the previous season's sowing of 30705 acres. Average rainfall for the period from 01.06.2022 to 27.07.2022 has reached 675.8 mm higher as compared to the previous season of 546.6 mm.
