Sugar Fundamental Report

16th Sep, 2022

Recent Update:

Sugar physical market showed a stable trend today in India. Sugar prices were slightly higher in the Delhi market at Rs. 3520/qtl whereas prices were stable in Kolhapur at Rs. 3400 per quintal.

AgriWatch expects sugar crushing to start from 1-2nd week October 2022 for the coming 2022-23 season in Maharashtra. As per the sources, currently the sugarcane crop condition is good in Maharashtra and yield is expected to improve in the coming season. No major crop damage has been reported so far.

Although, in Uttar Pradesh, the crop yield and sugar recovery are expected to decline due to lower rains in July-August. Sugarcane crushing in Uttar Pradesh is expected to begin from 15th October 2022.

Andhra Pradesh Sugarcane sowing has reached 0.38 lakh hectares for the 2022-23 season which is slightly lower as compared to the previous season's sowing of 0.43 lakh hectares, till 14th Sept 2022. However, average rainfall for the period from 01.06.2022 to 14.09.2022 has reached 528 mm higher as compared to the previous season of 484 mm across the state.

As of 14th Sept 2022, Telangana Sugarcane sowing has reached 36987 acres for the 2022-23 season which is slightly higher compared to the previous season's sowing of 34072 acres. Average rainfall

for the period from 01.06.2022 to 14.09.2022 has reached 1028 mm higher as compared to the previous season of 881 mm across the state.

According to the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare data, till 09th September 2022, the area under sugarcane cultivation has reached 55.65 lakh hectares as compared to 54.70 lakh hectares during the previous season.

The Indian Sugar Mills Association has demanded that the government should allow 80 lakh tonnes of exports in the coming 2022-23 season. As per the association, the sugar production in 2022-23 season is expected to be 355 lakh tonnes which is around 5 lakh tonnes lower from the 2021-22 season of 360

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lakh tonnes. The exports of surplus sugar would also help in maintaining domestic sugar prices, which in turn boost the liquidity position of mills enabling them to pay (FRP) sugarcane farmers on time.

Weather Forecast

Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Gujarat State, Madhya Maharashtra, Konkan & Goa, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal, Sikkim, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, Tripura, Saurashtra & Kutch. Thunderstorms accompanied by lightning at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Odisha, Assam & Meghalaya, Gujarat State, Interior Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry, Karikal.

Previous Domestic Market Updates:

Maharashtra government has urged the center to reduce the interest on delayed Fair and Remunerative Price (FRP) payments to the farmers from 15 percent to 7.5 percent. Earlier, as per Sugarcane Control Order, FRP to the farmers should be paid within 14 days of the procurement of sugarcane. Also, the failure to comply with the 14-day deadline would result in interest of 15 percent per annum. The State has also demanded a rise in the Minimum Selling Price of sugar from Rs. 3,100 per quintal to Rs. 3,600 for the 2022-23 season.

International Market Updates:

According to UNICA, sugar production in Brazil has increased by 5.77% to 3.13 million tonnes during the first half of August 2022. The allocation to sugar production has been increased to 48.4% as against 46.4% last season. This has resulted in lower ethanol output falling 1.23% to 2.25 billion liters. Earlier, sugar production was expected to fall but with the increase in arrivals and good crop conditions, production has now revived.
