#### **Recent Update:**

**Sugar physical market showed a stable trend today in India.** Sugar prices were higher in the Delhi market at Rs. 3490/qtl whereas prices in Kolhapur at Rs. 3500 per quintal.

According to the First Advance Estimates for 2022-23, total foodgrain production in the country is estimated at 149.92 million tonnes which is higher by 6.98 million tonnes than the average foodgrain production of previous five years' (2016-17 to 2020-21). Total Sugarcane production in the country during 2022-23 is estimated at record 465.05 million tonnes. The production of sugarcane during 2022-23 is higher by 91.59 million tonnes than the average sugarcane production of 373.46 million tonnes.

#### **Weather Forecast**

Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal, Sikkim, Himachal Pradesh, Bihar, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, Tripura. Thunderstorms accompanied by lightning at isolated places over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan, Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal, Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, Tripura, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry & Karikal.

#### **Previous Domestic Market Updates:**

As of 21<sup>st</sup> Sept 2022, Andhra Pradesh Sugarcane sowing has reached 0.38 lakh hecatres for the 2022-23 season which is lower compared to the previous season's sowing of 0.44 lakh hecatres. Average rainfall for the period from 01.06.2022 to 21.09.2022 has reached 544 mm across the state.

As of 21<sup>st</sup> Sept 2022, Telangana Sugarcane sowing has reached 37097 acres for the 2022-23 season which is slightly lower compared to the previous season's sowing of 51458 acres. Average rainfall for the period from 01.06.2022 to 21.09.2022 has reached 1051 mm higher as compared to the previous season of 910 mm across the state.

According to the Maharashtra government, sugarcane crushing season is likely to start from 15<sup>th</sup> October 2022. The sugarcane crushing season is expected to be of 160 days and the prices for sugarcane are likely to be Rs. 3050 per tonne for recovery of 10.25%. Around 203 sugar mills are expected to participate in the 2022-23 crushing season. Sugar mills in Maharashtra has cleared 98% of FRP to the sugarcane farmers for the 2021-22 season so far.

As of Sept. 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Sugarcane sowing has reached 55.65 Lakh Ha. Vs 54.97 Lakh Ha. same period last year.

Sugar mills in Uttar Pradesh has cleared cane dues of around Rs. 30,368.73 crore till 01<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Sugar mills are yet to clear dues of Rs. 4,832 crore to cane farmers across the state.

Before the start of the sugarcane crushing season, various state governments are demanding the center to release the sugar export policy for the coming 2022-23 season starting from October. Uttar Pradesh sugar industry is demanding allocation of mill-wise export quota while the sugar mills from Maharashtra, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu are demanding exports through open general license policy (OGL). Earlier, Indian Sugar Mills Association had also asked for mill-wise Maximum Admissible Export Quota (MAEQ) for 2022-23 season.

#### **International Market Updates:**

According to UNICA, sugar production in Brazil has increased by 5.77% to 3.13 million tonnes during the first half of August 2022. The allocation to sugar production has been increased to 48.4% as against 46.4% last season. This has resulted in lower ethanol output falling 1.23% to 2.25 billion liters. Earlier, sugar production was expected to fall but with the increase in arrivals and good crop conditions, production has now revived.

**Ethanol:** According to the market sources, the center may hike the ethanol purchase price by Rs.2 per liter for the 2022-23 season (Dec-Nov). According to the Ministry of petroleum and natural gas, the government has achieved 10.3% ethanol blending in petrol as of June 2022, ahead of the November 2022 deadline. Earlier, during the 2021-22 season, the government increased the procurement price of all three categories of ethanol produced from different sources by 1.27 to 2.55 percent.
