

Recent Update:

Sugar physical market showed a steady trend today in India. Sugar prices were higher in the Delhi market at Rs. 3540/qtl whereas prices in Kolhapur were at Rs. 3500 per quintal.

In a notification issued on 30th September 2022, the food ministry has allocated higher monthly sales quota of 23.5 Lakh MT (LMT) for monthly October 2022, compared to 0.5 LMT lower allocated during October 2021. During the previous month government allocated 23.5 LMT quota. As per Agriwatch Sources, demand is expected to increase with the beginning of the new sugar 2022-23 season, with upcoming festival season in October 2022.

According to the market sources, sugar exports may get affected in Uttar Pradesh during the 2022-23 season. With the expectation of lower production during the 2022-23 season in the state. Sugar exports may get affected. According to the market sources, Sugar production is likely to be 100 MT during the 2022-23 season and consumption is likely to be 40 MT, the state is likely to face a glut-like situation leading the mills to store sugar stocks in their warehouses if the state fails to push the sale of the sweetener in the national market.

Whereas, as per Agriwatch Sources, due to lower rains in the July-Aug month, sugar recovery is expected to be lower in the state which will further affect the sugar production in the state. Sugar production is likely to be lower than 100 lakh tonnes in the 2022-23 season. Also, Sugarcane crushing is likely to begin in the state after Diwali festival.

As of 28th Sept 2022, Andhra Pradesh Sugarcane sowing has reached 0.39 lakh hectares for the 2022-23 season which is slightly lower compared to the previous season's sowing of 0.44 lakh hectares. Average rainfall for the period from 01.06.2022 to 28.09.2022 has reached 563.2 mm against the normal of 562 mm in the state.

The Department of Agriculture, Rajasthan has released its first advance estimate for the 2022-23 season. Overall sugarcane production in the state is expected to reach 341622 tonnes during the 2022-23 season. The area under sugarcane cultivation in the state has reached 4780 hectares. The average yield is expected to be 714 kgs per hectare in the 2022-23 season.

International Market Updates:

According to the Commerce Ministry, China has fixed its sugar imports at 1.945 million tonnes for the 2022-23 season, which is the same as that of the previous season. As per the sources 70% of the quota is likely to state-owned firms. As a result, Agriwatch expects India to have good opportunity for exports during the 2022-23 season.

According to the Fiji Sugar Corporation, the sugar mills in the country had produced 109,554 tonnes till 19th September 2022 after crushing 1 million tonnes of cane. The sugar recovery rate is expected to improve in the coming 2022-23 season.

According to UNICA, sugarcane crushing in Brazil has increased by 2.5% to 39.49 million tonnes during the first half of September 2022. The allocation to sugar production has been increased to 48.4% as against 46.4% last season. Earlier, sugar production was expected to fall but with the increase in arrivals and good sugar recovery, production has now increased in Brazil.

Ethanol: According to the market sources, the center may hike the ethanol purchase price by Rs.2 per liter for the 2022-23 season (Dec-Nov). According to the Ministry of petroleum and natural gas, the government has achieved 10.3% ethanol blending in petrol as of June 2022, ahead of the November 2022 deadline. Earlier, during the 2021-22 season, the government increased the procurement price of all three categories of ethanol produced from different sources by 1.27 to 2.55 percent.

Note: Brazil Ethanol production has increased by 2% to 2.12 billion litres till the first half of September 2022.
