

## **Sugar Fundamental Report**

18<sup>th</sup> Oct, 2022

### **Recent Update:**

**Sugar physical market showed a mixed trend today in India.** Sugar prices were stable in the Delhi market at Rs. 3510/qtl and in Kolhapur were at Rs. 3380 per quintal.

Indian Sugar Mills Association has revised its sugar production estimate for the 2022-23 season. ISMA has estimated sugar production at 365 lakh tonnes for the 2022-23 season which was 354 lakh tonnes estimated previously. The area under sugarcane is estimated to be around 59 lakh hectares in 2022-23 season, which is about 6% higher than 2021-22 sugar season's area of around 56 lakh hectares.

According to the market sources, Sugar mills in Maharashtra are likely to start their sugarcane crushing from 15<sup>th</sup> October 2022. Around 203 sugar mills are likely to participate in the cane crushing operation out of the total 246 sugar mills in the state. So far 35 sugar mills had taken permission for cane crushing in the 2022-23 season. About 1,413 tonnes of cane is likely to get crushed in the state during the 2022-23 season.

As per Andhra Pradesh agricultural department, as on 12th October 2022 Sugarcane sowing activity completed around 0.37 lakh hectares as compared to last year same period 0.44 lakh hectares in the 2021-22 season. Overall, the average rainfall received in Andhra Pradesh from

01.06.2022 to 06.10.2022 is recorded as 695.1 mm as against the Normal as on date of 668.5 mm showing by Normal 4.0 percent.

### **Weather Forecast**

Heavy rainfall at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe, Lakshadweep. Thunderstorms accompanied by lightning at isolated places over Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Konkan & Goa, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Yanam, Rayalaseema, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry & Karaikal, Lakshadweep, Kerala & Mahe.

#### **International Market Updates:**

Bangladesh government has increased the prices of sugar by Tk 6 per kg. The price of packaged sugar has been increased from Tk 89 to Tk 95 as per the announcement made by the commerce ministry. Earlier on September 22, sugar prices of unpackaged refined sugar were at Tk 84 per kg and for packaged sugar was Tk 89 per kg for the local market.

According to UNICA, sugarcane crushing in Brazil has increased by 2.5% to 39.49 million tonnes during the first half of September 2022. The allocation to sugar production has been increased to 48.4% as against 46.4% last season. Earlier, sugar production was expected to fall but with the increase in arrivals and good sugar recovery, production has now increased in Brazil.

**Ethanol:** According to the market sources, the center may hike the ethanol purchase price by Rs.2 per liter for the 2022-23 season (Dec-Nov). According to the Ministry of petroleum and natural gas, the government has achieved 10.3% ethanol blending in petrol as of September 2022, ahead of the November 2022 deadline. Earlier, during the 2021-22 season, the government increased the procurement price of all three categories of ethanol produced from different sources by 1.27 to 2.55 percent. (To achieve 20 percent blending by 2025, India needs 10.2-11 billion litres of ethanol.

During the ethanol supply year 2021-22, till 04<sup>th</sup> September 2022, around 3.33 billion litres of ethanol has been supplied, out of which sugar industry has contributed about 2.87 billion litres (86%) and grain-based distillers the rest.

Note: Brazil Ethanol production has increased by 2% to 2.12 billion litres till the first half of September 2022.
