## **Recent Update:**

**Sugar physical market showed a stable trend today in India.** Sugar prices in the Kolhapur market remained lower at Rs. 3595 per quintal. In Delhi market prices were at Rs. 3610 per quintal.

- As per NFCSF, Gujarat has topped in the average sugar recovery in the country with 10.80%, followed by Karnataka (10.10%), Telangana (10.10%), Maharashtra (10%), Andhra Pradesh (9.70%), Bihar (9.70%), and Uttar Pradesh (9.65%) during the 2022-23 season.
- The National Federation of Cooperative Sugar Federation (NFCSF) has estimated sugar production at 327.35 lakh tonnes of sugar for the 2022-23 season. Till 30<sup>th</sup> April 2023 sugar production has reached 320.30 lakh tonne. The 2022-23 sugar season is expected to end of May and it is estimated to produce about 327 lakh tonnes of new sugar. In addition, about 45 lakh tonnes of sugar is estimated to be diverted to ethanol production.
  - Sugarcane area is expected to reduce in the coming season in Haryana. Around 70% of the area under cultivation of the Co-0238 variety of cane is likely to get reduced due to the attack of top borer insects and red-rot disease on the crop.
- The National Federation of Cooperative Sugar Federation (NFCSF) has estimated sugar production at 327.35 lakh tonnes of sugar for the 2022-23 season. Till 30<sup>th</sup> April 2023 sugar production has reached 320.30 lakh tonne. The 2022-23 sugar season is expected to end of May and it is estimated to produce about 327 lakh tonnes of new sugar. In addition, about 45 lakh tonnes of sugar is estimated to be diverted to ethanol production.

### **International Market**

- Sugarcane production in Thailand may fall in the coming season mainly due to expectation of El Nino phenomenon and farmers shifting to other profitable crops, sugarcane output for 2023-24 is expected to fall by 21% to 74 million compared to the 2022-23 season. Despite record-high prices for cane, the area under cane cultivation may reduce in Thailand
- As per the market sources, the global sugar supply is moving towards a lower surplus of 1.1 million tonnes in 2022-23 season as against the previous estimates of a 2.5 million tonnes surplus made in March after lower yields in countries like India, Mexico and the European Union.

## **Ethanol:**

During the 2022-23 season Ethanol production in Central south region of Brazil has increased by 5%. Total ethanol production for the 2022-23 harvest season reached 28.91 billion liters, up 5 percent. Production included 16.62 billion liters of hydrous ethanol, down 0.57 percent, and 12.29 billion liters of anhydrous ethanol, up 16.68 percent.
