

# **Sugar Fundamental Report**

16<sup>th</sup> May, 2023

## **Recent Update:**

Sugar physical market showed a stable trend today in India. Sugar prices in the Mumbai was higher by Rs.6 per quintals.

- Sugarcane crushing season has entered its last stage of crushing for the 2022-23 season across India.
- As per NFCSF, Gujarat has topped in the average sugar recovery in the country with 10.80%, followed by Karnataka (10.10%), Telangana (10.10%), Maharashtra (10%), Andhra Pradesh (9.70%), Bihar (9.70%), and Uttar Pradesh (9.65%) during the 2022-23 season.
- The National Federation of Cooperative Sugar Federation (NFCSF) has estimated sugar production at 327.35 lakh tonnes of sugar for the 2022-23 season. Till 30<sup>th</sup> April 2023 sugar production has reached 320.30 lakh tonne. The 2022-23 sugar season is expected to end of May and it is estimated to produce about 327 lakh tonnes of new sugar. In addition, about 45 lakh tonnes of sugar is estimated to be diverted to ethanol production.
- Sugarcane area is expected to reduce in the coming season in Haryana. Around 70% of the area under cultivation of the Co-0238 variety of cane is likely to get reduced due to the attack of top borer insects and red-rot disease on the crop.

## **International Market**

- Sugarcane crushing in center south region of Brazil has been affected in the second half of April month mainly due to bad weather which has delayed harvesting. Sugarcane crushing was reported at 21 million tonnes against the expectation of 25.59 million tonne in the second half of April. Sugar output was at 9,89,000 tonne.
- Despite record-high prices for cane, the area under cane cultivation may reduce in Thailand.
   Sugarcane production in Thailand may fall in the coming season mainly due to expectation of El Nino phenomenon and farmers shifting to other profitable crops, sugarcane output for 2023-24 is expected to fall by 21% to 74 million compared to the 2022-23 season. Despite record-high prices for cane, the area under cane cultivation may reduce in Thailand

Brazil Ethanol production in late April reported down 11.2% to 978 million litres compared to the previous season as mills are allocating more cane to sugar production due to rising sugar prices in the global market.
