



As per AgriWatch estimates, the overall sugar production is expected to increase to 33.5 MMT as compared to 30.9 lakh MMT in the 2021-22 season. The major reason behind the increase in production is the higher sown area of 54.97 lakh hectares in 2021-22 as compared to 54.08 lakh hectares in 2020-21 season. Also, good rains earlier in the season has resulted in better yield. Exports for the 2021-22 season is expected to reach 90 lakh tonne in 2021-22 season, as sugar demand has increased from the international market. Domestic Consumption is also expected to increase in 2021-22 season to 27 MMT from 26.5 MMT in 2020-21 season. The stock to use ratio is expected to be at 4.14 percent in 2021-22 as compared to 6.64 percent in 2020-21.

Domestic Market Highlights

Recent Updates:





Government of India has allotted the monthly sugar sale quota of 22.5 lakh MT for the month of May which is 50,000 MT higher from previous year. Consideration of higher sale quota is mainly due to expectation of higher summer demand.

According to the Ministry of consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, Indian Sugar production in the 2021-22 season is expected to be higher by 12 percent in the current season as compared to the previous season. The sugar production for the 2021-22 season is estimated to be about 350 Lakh Metric Tonne (LMT) against estimated domestic consumption of about 278 LMT. Higher acreages amid good rainfall early in the season over Maharashtra and southern India has resulted in higher yields in the 2021-22 season.

Sugarcane crushing season is in the final crushing phase across India. Around 217 sugar mills are currently operating in India. Sugar mills have produced around 342.37 lakh tonne of sugar till 31st April'2022 as against 300.92 lakh tonne produced same period last year. The States of Andhra Pradesh & Telangana, Bihar, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana and Madhya Pradesh & Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan, Odisha have collectively produced 32.36 lakh tonne of sugar till 31st April, 2022. Out of the above states, Bihar, Odisha and Rajasthan have closed their crushing operations for the current season. Among other states, 13 sugar mills in Punjab, 1 sugar mill in Haryana, 2 sugar mills in Uttarakhand, 12 sugar mills in M.P, 2 sugar mills in Chhattisgarh, 2 sugar mills in A.P. and 6 sugar mills in Telangana have closed their operations.

AgriWatch expects sugar exports to reach 90 lakh tonne during the 2021-22 season. According to Indian Sugar Mills Association, around 82-83 lakh tonne of sugar exports contracts have already been signed till 31st April'2022. Out of which, about 68-70 akh tonnes of sugar is estimated to have been physically exported from India up to 31st April 2022 as compared to about 43.19 lakh tonnes exported last year during the corresponding period. The major export destination during the 2021-22 sugar season are Indonesia and Bangladesh.

The Maharashtra government has announced subsidies to sugar factories to ensure that they continue to operate till the June month. An estimated 35 lakh tonnes of sugarcane are yet to be crushed in Maharashtra. The state government will provide a transport subsidy of Rs. 5 per tonne on cane that is to be transported beyond 50 km from 01st May 2022 and also for the decline in sugar recovery with the rising temperature, the subsidy will be provided which is Rs. 200 per tonne for sugar recovery above or 0.5 percent of final recovery 0f 10 percent.


Price Outlook:

Sugar prices had slightly increased in the major markets across India last month because of the good demand in the market. The average sugar prices were higher at Rs. 3443 per quintal from the previous month at Rs.3414 per quintal in Delhi market. The prices in Maharashtra also stood slightly higher at Rs.3319/q in April'22 as compared to the previous month. Agriwatch expects prices to remain in the range of Rs. 3,350- Rs. 3,450 per quintal in the coming month.

Price Projection for the Next Month:

As per Agriwatch estimates, spot sugar prices (M grade) in benchmark Kolhapur market are likely to remain between Rs.3,250 -3,350 per quintal in May 2022.

International Market

Major Market Highlights:

As per the market sources, Sugar production in the center south region of Brazil is likely to increase the coming 2022-23 season. The sugarcane production may increase by 6.7 percent to 558 million tonnes in the 2022-23 season due to improved recovery of the fields from the drought last year. As a result, sugar production is expected to increase to 33.5 million tonnes as compared to 32.1 million tonnes in the 2021-22 season.

According to the Thai Sugar Millers Corporation, after two years of low output, sugar production in Thailand is likely to increase in the current season over good yield following favorable weather. The sugar mills have produced 9.6 million tonne of sugar by crushing 87.75 million tonne of cane till mid-April 2021-22. The sugar output in the last season was 6.7 million tonne and, in this season, it is expected to rise by 35% to 9 million tonne.

The sugar production in Pakistan likely to increase by 2 million tonne from last year to 7.5 million tonne. As a result, Pakistan is back to sugar surplus country from deficit. Ex-mill sugar prices are now around Rs 81/kg substantially lower from last year. Sugar production is higher in this season because of better yield.


ICE (Raw Sugar Exchange) Future Market Scenario (Jul'22 Contract) Technical Commentary:
