Domestic Market Highlights

- In the current season, 528 mills started their operations so far against 516 mills which operated last season, as on 15th February'2023. About 61 sugar mills have closed their crushing operations for the 2022-23 season, while 467 sugar mills are still operating in the country. During the previous 2021-22 season, around 32 sugar mills had closed their crushing operation and 484 mills were functioning on the corresponding date.
- Maharashtra sugar production is expected to decline in the 2022-23 season. The adverse climatic conditions have impacted sugarcane production in Maharashtra during the ongoing season. Early flowering during the season has largely impacted the sugar yield which has resulted in lower production.
- Sugar production is estimated at 124 lakh tonnes in the 2022-23 season for Maharashtra, lower from the previous crop of 137.28 lakh tonne during the 2021-22 season. AgriWatch estimates sugar production across India for the 2022-23 season at 345 lakh tonne against 356 lakh tonne in the 2021-22 season.
- The sugarcane crushing season is expected to get over by March end in Sangli, Satara and Kolhapur districts whereas in Marathwada it will end by April.
- According to National Federation of Cooperative Sugar Factories, Till 28th February 2023, Around 2653 lakh tonnes of sugarcane has been crushed which is 102 lakh tonnes more than last year. The sugar production was 260 lakhs tonnes, which is 7 lakh tonnes more than the production on this date last year. However, average sugar recovery was recorded at 9.78 percent.
- Sugar production is expected to pick up in the coming 2023-24 season. Although the United States Meteorological Department has hinted at the threat of El Nino by the end of July, the dams, water reservoirs and soil moisture due to the excess rainfall last year have been filled, and before the outbreak of El Nino, general rainfall is expected in the months of June-July. Also, there is little possibility of adverse effects of El Nino on sugar production and the crushing season of 2023-24.
- As is the practice, ISMA procured satellite images of cane area in the 2nd week of Jan' 2023. The satellite pictures have given a good idea of the area already harvested and remaining unharvested area in the fields across the country.



According to the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare Second Advance estimate, total sugarcane production in India for the 2022-23 season may reach a record high of 4687.89 lakh tonnes representing a increase of 293.64 lakh tonne from previous year production of 4394.25 lakh tonne. As per Agriwatch, the expectation of increase in production was mainly from some parts of Maharashtra and Karnataka.

Domestic Sales Quota:

The food ministry has allocated higher monthly sale quota for March 2023. About 22 LMT of monthly sales quota has been allocated for March 2023, which is 0.5 LMT higher than the monthly sales quota for March 2022. With the increasing temperature and early summer season, sugar demand is likely to increase in the coming month.



Sugar Prices:

As sugar demand was comparatively improved. Prices during the 2022-23 season are expected to increase in anticipation of increase in domestic consumption during the 2022-23 season along with expected decline in domestic sugar production. However, sugar prices are likely to increase in the coming March month mainly due to expectation of improved demand in the domestic market.


Sugar Export:

- With the lower sugar production expectation government is not likely to allow sugar exports further. As per National Sugar Federation Sugar production for the 2022-23 season is likely to be lower by 7% at 335 lakh tonne against previous season 359 lakh tonne. The lower sugarcane yield from Maharashtra and Karnataka has resulted in lower sugar production and poor recovery.
- Also, the lower sugar output will not lead to a spike in domestic prices this year as the demand for sugar is around 27 MMT per year.
- Over 35 lakh tonnes (LT) sugar have been dispatched by sugar mills to ports and refineries in special economic zones (SEZs) for exports in the current season (October 2022-September 2023).
- According to the All-India Sugar Traders Association (AISTA), 27.83 LT of sugar have been physically exported out of the 35.87 LT dispatched by the mills.
- While 3.7 LT have been delivered to refineries in SEZs, considered as deemed exports and the remaining 4.24 LT is either being loaded or waiting to be loaded onto vessels.
- Bangladesh and Indonesia are the top buyers of Indian sugar purchasing 2.70 LT and 2.61 LT, respectively. Djibouti has imported 2.47 LT of Indian sugar, while Somalia has bought 2.46 LT. The United Arab Emirates follows next purchasing 2.06 LT, Sudan has bought 1.66 LT and Saudi Arabia 1.65 lt. Malaysia, Sri Lanka, China (1.12 LT), Iraq, Afghanistan and Cameroon are other significant importers of Indian sugar.

India has a limited opportunity for exports during the 2022-23 season.

The Center South region Brazil indicates higher sugar production for the 2022-23 and 2023-24 seasons (April – March). As per market sources, the 2023-24 Sugar season in CS Brazil is set to recover to over 36 million tonnes of sugar production, up from 33 million tonnes estimated for 2022-23 season. This sugar will be available in the global market by May,2023.

Similarly, Thailand production is also expected to increase to around 11.5 -12 million tonnes in 2022-23 season. The Raw sugar futures for May'2023 can be delivered up to 28th April,2023. Therefore, Opportunity for Indian sugar mills to export maximum sugar is up to April, 2023.





As per AgriWatch, Sugar exports during the 2022-23 season is expected to be 70 lakh tonne as the domestic prices are currently lower as compared to the international prices. Government has been encouraging sugar mills to divert sugar to ethanol and also to export surplus sugar so that sugar mills may make payments of cane dues to farmers in time and also mills may have better financial conditions to continue their operation for the coming season. About 45 lakh tonne of sugar is expected to be diverted for ethanol production during the 2022-23 season.

Sugarcane dues:

- According to the UP-Sugar Mills Association, sugar mills across the state have cleared around 45% of the cane dues for the ongoing 2022-23 crushing season. Out of the Rs. 1740.28 lakh of cane dues, sugar mills have cleared about Rs. 789.39 lakh.
- However, the government has not increased the State Advised Price (SAP) for the 2022-23 season as the mills are already burdened with the pressure of less revenue recovery due to the low cost of sugar in the open market. The government is currently focusing on timely cane payments to farmers rather than hiking SAP.

During the previous 2021-22 sugar season, sugar mills procured sugarcane worth more than 1.18 lakh crore and released payments of around 1.12 lakh crore with no financial assistance from the government of India. Thus, cane dues at the end of sugar season are less than Rs. 6,000 crore indicating that 95% of cane dues have already been cleared. In the previous, 2020-21 season government has cleared more than 99% cane dues.

AgriWatch has revised its sugar production at 33.81 MMT in the 2022-23 season, lower from 2021-22 season due to lower sugar recovery expectations from Maharashtra and Karnataka. Exports for the 2022-23 season are expected to reach 7.0 MMT. Further, domestic consumption is expected to improve in 2022-23 season to 27.5 MMT from 26.2 MMT in 2021-22 season.


Price Outlook:

Sugar prices had decreased in the major markets across India last month due to improved supply in the domestic market. The average sugar prices were down by Rs. 3415 per quintal in February 2023 from the previous month at Rs.3441 per quintal in Delhi market. Prices in Maharashtra also stood slightly higher at Rs. 3282/q in Feb'23 as compared to the previous month of Rs.3266/q in Jan'23.

Price Projection for the Next Month:


As per AgriWatch estimates, spot sugar prices (M grade) in the benchmark Kolhapur market are likely to remain between Rs.3,200 -3,350 per quintal in March 2023. In Shamli market prices were trading steady at Rs. 3410 per Quintal. Prices may increase in the coming month due to expectation of increased summer demand.

Major Market Highlights:

The National Board of Revenue (NBR), Bangladesh has withdrawn import duty on both raw and refined sugar. NBR has issued a notification to withdraw a 3,000 taka (about \$28) specific duty on the import of raw sugar and a 6000 taka duty on refined sugar per tonne with immediate effect. The regulatory duty on the import

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of sugar was also reduced to 25% from 30%. This government decision will help in maintaining the prices in the domestic market.

International Sugar Organization has revised the sugar production estimated to rise from 172.52 million tonne to 180.43 million tonne for the 2022-23 season. Meanwhile, consumption is projected to rise to 176.280 million tonne, up from 174.773 million tonnes last season. The projected trade balance has a surplus of 0.404 million tonne in 2022-23 season and 0.765 million tonnes in 2021-22 season.

ISO's fundamental view has changed from neutral-to-bearish to neutral for the next three months. In mid-January, raw sugar prices rose sharply supported by speculators re-establishing long positions. Meanwhile, the market continues to face a futures board in backwardation.

The Jaggery arrivals in Anakapalle have declined by around 30-40% in the 2022-23 season as compared to the previous season. About 6,000-8,000 jaggery lumps are arriving per day against the previous season of 10,000-14,000. The major reason behind the lower arrivals is lower production as farmers have switched to other crops from Anakapalle and Vizianagaram districts.

As per AgriWatch sources, Jaggery-making units in Uttar Pradesh are working on a lower scale as winter season is almost over, along with it there is enough stock available in the market.

World ethanol production in 2022 is estimated to have reached 109.4 billion liters, up from 104.6 billion liters in 2021. For 2023, ethanol output is expected to recover further, reaching 111.8 billion liters. Meanwhile ethanol consumption is expected to be at 104.2 billion liters in 2022, revised lower from 104.5 billion liters. Consumption in 2023 is expected to rise to 106.9 billion liters, driven by increases in India.

Ethanol production in Uttar Pradesh is likely to cross the 135 crore liters mark during the ongoing fiscal as more distilleries are engaged in producing ethanol in the last year. The distilleries in the state have produced 97 crore liters of ethanol during the 2021-22 fiscal.
