

#### **Price Outlook:**


Sugar mills have produced around 258.68 lakh tonnes of sugar till 15<sup>th</sup> March'21.Sugar mills are now at their final phase of crushing and about 171 sugar mills have ended their cane crushing operation across the country. The average sugar prices decreased in Khatauli market at Rs.3076/q from Rs3150/q previous week. The prices in Maharashtra also stood slightly firm at Rs.3300/q.

#### **Price Projection for the Next week**

As per the Agriwatch estimates, spot sugar prices (M grade) in benchmark Kolhapur market are likely to remain steady and in range next week between Rs.3100 -3170 per quintal for next week.

#### **Domestic Sugar Market Summary**

Average prices for sugar 'M' grade in key Kolhapur market were range boundatRs.3150per quintal, while spot sugar prices for the same grade in Shamli district stood at Rs.3069per quintal during the week.



#### **Domestic Market Highlights**

#### **Recent Updates:**

About 76 percent of the sugarcane has been harvested till 19<sup>th</sup> March 21. About 48.51 lakh hectares was the estimated total coverage under sugarcane in the rabi season of 2020-21 and around 76 percent harvesting has been done till 19<sup>th</sup> March'21. In some parts of the country, the sugar mills have closed their crushing operations while some are at their final phase of crushing.

#### **Previous Updates**

• About 4.3 million tonnes of export contracts have been signed in sugar season 2020-21. According to Indian Sugar Mills Association, around 43 lakh tonnes of export contracts have been signed, these contracts have been signed in just 2 ½ months, since the date the export quotas were allocated by the Government on 31st December, 2020. The total sugar export quota is around 60 lakh for 2020-21 season. About 3.18 lakh tons of sugar had been exported in Oct. – Dec., 2020, against the Maximum Admissible Export Quota (MAEQ) of last season 2019-20 Season and another around 22 lakh tons of physical exports are expected between Jan. – March, 2021 against MAEQ of 2020-21 sugar season.



- India's Sugar production is up by 19.69 percent compared to previous year. According to Indian Sugar Mills Association, around 258.68 lac tons of sugar have been produced till 15<sup>th</sup> March'21 against 216.13 lac tons produced last year by 15<sup>th</sup> March'20. About 171 mills have stopped cane crushing operation and 331 sugar mills are currently operating in the country against 319 mills operating previous year, till 15<sup>th</sup> march'20 around 138 sugar mills had stopped cane crushing operations.
- Bihar is set to become the first state in the country to have a dedicated ethanol policy. With the central government approval for producing ethanol directly from sugarcane and broken rice, Bihar is planning to launch country's first ethanol policy. 20 investors have already applied for production units, Bihar produces 12,000 crorelitres of ethanol each year and is expected to produce 50,000 crorelitres each year after proposals of 20 new ethanol units were realized.
- Crushing operation is expected to get over in Maharashtra and Karnataka by March and in Uttar Pradesh by May. The sugar production would be slightly lower than the initial estimate in Uttar Pradesh. Production in Uttar Pradesh is expected to be 10.2 million tonnes in the current 2020-21 year, lower than 12.6 million tonnes last year. Similarly, the output in Maharashtra is expected to be 10.2 million tonnes this year compared with 6.1 million tonnes last year. The initial sugar production estimate for each of these two states was 10.5 million tonne for the current year, Where else production in Karnataka, is expected to increase to 4.7 million tonne in the 2020-21 marketing year from 3.45 million tonne last year.

#### Technical Analysis - Sugar (M grade) Spot Market at Kolhapur market

- The sugar spot prices at benchmark Kolhapur market remained high duringlast week and ended at Rs.3150/q.
- Next resistance and support level for the next week is expected at Rs.3200 and Rs.3100 per quintal respectively.
- RSI is in the neutral region.





### Technical Analysis - ChakuSukha-gur(fresh) at Spot (Muzaffarnagar)market. Gur Market Scenario

- There was a decrease in arrivals and it stood around 38000 last week of Chaku variety of gur in key Muzaffarnagar market.
- The average price during the week decreasedat Rs. 2725/q and the prices in the last year during the same timewere lower at Rs. 2749/q.
- RSI stood in the neutral region.



#### **International Market Highlights**

#### **Recent Updates:**

**Kyrgyzstan has banned sugar exports.** The rising prices of sugar in the domestic market have led the Kyrgyzstan government to impose a ban on the exportation of sugar. The government is trying all the possible ways to come over the shortage of sugar in the country and the lower prices.

#### **Previous Updates**

- According to the Pakistan Sugar Mills Association (PSMA), the prices of sugar are likely to increase above Rs 89 per kg. The country may face shortage of sugar with the coming Ramzan, as a result Pakistan may import 50,000 metric tonnes of sugar in the current season.
- Brazil sugar output is likely to fall at 36.7 million tonnes in the new crop season that begins in April as compared to 38.5 million tonnes in the previous season. The unfavourable weather has affected the



sugar output in the region. The sugarcane production is likely to fall from 607 million tonnes in 2020-21 to 586 million tonnes in 2021-22. The ethanol production may also fall to 30.6 billion litres from the previous year of 29.4 billion litres. Brazil ethanol exports have increased around 4.1 percent in February'21. Brazil has exported 156.66 million litres of ethanol in February'21, the exports have reached 343.31 million litres in the first two months of 2021. The country has exported maximum ethanol to South Korea (81.83 million), Netherland (23.83 million) and china (16.22 million litres) and U.S. around 1.85 million litres.

Nepal sugar mills shuts operation without paying cane dues. The Mahalakshmi Sugar Mill has closed
down its operations for this season without paying cane dues to the farmers. The mill has closed operations
after crushing 890,000 quintals of sugarcane. The farmers have stated that they have not received cane dues
from the mill except for the cane dues for the first five days.








## ICE (Raw Sugar Exchange) Future Market Scenario (May'21 Contract) Technical Commentary:
