Price Outlook:


The Central governments and the State government are focusing on ethanol production as the 2020-21 season has come to an end. Crushing is going on in Tamil Nadu. The Assam government has approved ethanol production promotion policy, 2021 in the last week and it shall be valid up to 31st March 2021.Sugar production for 2020-21 seasons are estimated at 309 lakh tonnes. The average sugar prices were higher at Rs. 3308/q from the previous week at Rs.3221/q in Delhi market. The prices in Maharashtra also stood slightly firm at Rs.3141/q.

Price Projection for the Next week

As per the Agriwatch estimates, spot sugar prices (M grade) in the benchmark Kolhapur market are likely to remain steady and in range next week between Rs.3100 -3150 per quintal for next week.

Domestic Sugar Market Summary

Average prices for sugar 'M' grade in key Kolhapur market were range boundatRs.3140per quintal, while in Shamli district there were no arrivals during the last week.

Recent Updates:

Assam has approved ethanol production policy. The Assam government has approved ethanol production promotion policy, 2021 and it shall be valid up to 31st March 2021. The policy will increase ethanol production in the state; also the standalone green field ethanol producing industrial units will be provided incentives under the policy.


Previous Updates

- NFCSF demands hike in minimum Selling Price of sugar. The National Federation of Cooperative Sugar Factories Limited (NFCSF) has demanded that the government to rise the minimum selling price of sugar from Rs. 31 per kg to above Rs. 37.50. They have also demanded grade wise pricing of sugar (small, medium and large size) to remove the current anomaly.
- Domestic Sugar prices have increased after 7 months. The domestic sugar prices have seen an uptrend since last 3 days by aggressive offerings and lifting. Demand is expected to increase with the dawn of the most auspicious Hindu month Shravan, the ease in many states imposed lockdown has also brought in demand. Prices have witnessed an upswing of average Rs. 80-100 per quintal nationwide after depressed prices for 7 constant months. Sugar prices in Maharashtra were at Rs. 3120 per quintal to Rs. 3155 per quintal for S grade whereas for M grade it was Rs. 3180 to Rs. 3250 per quintal.
- Madhya Pradesh government is planning to boost ethanol production in the state. The state government along with the Central government is planning to boost ethanol production in Madhya Pradesh. The Private players are setting up 20 ethanol units in the state. Currently India's ethanol blending rate with petrol is 8 percent. Also, the central government with an aim to lower the expenditure on foreign exchange has set a target of blending 20 per cent ethanol with petrol by 2025.
- Uttar Pradesh leads in ethanol production in India. The state has produced 58 crore litres of ethanol and the total operated distillers were 54, the average ethanol blending rate has reached 7.93 percent. Ethanol output is likely to increase in the upcoming season 2021-22 as government has emphasized its production.

Technical Analysis - Sugar (M grade) Spot Market at Kolhapur market

- The sugar spot prices at the benchmark Kolhapur market was higher during last week and ended at Rs.3141/q.
- The next resistance and support level for the next week is expected at Rs.3150 and Rs.3100 per quintal respectively.

International Market Highlights

Recent Updates:

Fiji sugar production has reached 24,000 tonnes till 1st August 2021. According to the Fiji Sugar Corporation (FSC) sugar mills have crushed around 283,000 tonnes of cane and produced 24,000 tonnes of sugar till 1st August 2021. The mills have crushed the sugarcane with an average TCTS (tonnes cane to tonnes sugar) of 11.91. As per National Farmer Union, all the three sugar mills are under performing due to mechanical and processing problems that are hampering the performance of the mills. This is causing huge loss to farmers and the sugar industry as a whole. Whereas on the other hand Fiji Sugar Corporation said that there is an issue of cane supply at Labasa sugar mill and there were minor issues at the Lautoka and Rarawai mills in the first 2 weeks of the season which have been resolved and all mills are operating well now.

Previous Updates

- Brazil Sugar Production have decreased in July 2021. According to data released by the trade association, UNICA Sugar production in the center-south region of Brazil has lowered by 2.8 percent in the first half of July compared with last year. The mills in the region have produced 2.94 million tonnes of sugar. As per the information shared by the 24 mills, agriculture yield of sugarcane was 14% lower in the first half of July compared to last year. The mills have in the first half of July crushed 45.6 million tonnes of cane which was 2.3% less compared to last year. At the same time, ethanol production increased by 1.1% to 2.16 billion litres.
- India's production is forecasted to reach 35.6 million tonnes by 2030. According to FAO Agricultural Outlook Report, World Sugarcane production is projected to grow by 1 percent per annum and reach 1,960

million tonnes by 2030 with Brazil and India anticipated to contribute 65 percent of the change in global output. Brazil Sugar production is projected to increase to 41.0 ml t, production in India is forecasted to reach 35.6 ml t by 2030.

- Philippines sugar production reached at 2.13 million metric tonnes. According to the Sugar Regulatory Administration (SRA), Sugar output in Phillippines has reached 2.137 million metric tonnes in the first week of July which is slightly lower around 2.14 million MT during the same period last year. However, despite the decline, the sugar output in the country has already exceeded its set target. According to the SRA, the sugar production for the current season has surpassed the government's full-year target. The sugar crop year starts in September and ends in August.
- Thailand sugar millers predicts sugar production around 6.6 million tonnes in 2020-21 season. According to the Thai Sugar Millers Corporation, the domestic sugar production for the 2020-21 is around 6.6 million tonnes, which is lowest in the decade. Thailand had received less rainfall this year during the rainy season and also drought in the previous year which has impacted the sugar production. Many farmers are shifting to cassava which is drought resistant.




