

Price Outlook:


Sugar production for 2020-21 seasons are estimated at 309 lakh tonnes. Maharashtra Sugar mills will start the cane crushing operation from 15th October 2021. The average sugar prices have slightly decreased at Rs. 3563/q from the previous week at Rs.3575/q in Delhi market. The prices in Maharashtra stood high at Rs.3400/q.

Price Projection for the Next week

As per the Agriwatch estimates, spot sugar prices (M grade) in the benchmark Kolhapur market are likely to remain steady and in range next week between Rs.3450 -3550 per quintal for next week.

Domestic Sugar Market Summary

Average prices for sugar 'M' grade in key Kolhapur market were range boundatRs.3500per quintal, while in Shamli district there were no arrivals during the last week.



Domestic Market Highlights

Recent Updates:

• West Bengal has received 15 proposals to produce ethanol. West Bengal government aims to increase ethanol production in the state by setting up new plants to achieve the target of blending ethanol with petrol set by the centre. The state so far has received 15 proposals to produce ethanol. The total investment involved is Rs. 2,666 crore and around 4,000 direct employment is expected through this in the state.

Previous Updates

- Maharashtra Sugar mills will start the cane crushing operation from 15th October 2021. For the coming 2021-22 sugar season, sugar mills in Maharashtra will start the cane crushing operation from 15th October 2021. About 12.32 lakh hectares of area is under sugarcane cultivation in the state for the coming 2021-22 season and around 97 tonnes per hectare of sugarcane production is expected in the state. Mills are expected to crush 109.6 million tonnes of sugarcane to produce an estimated 11.2 million tonnes of sugar. About 193 sugar mills are expected to participate in the cane crushing operation during 2021-22 seasons.
- Sugarcane crop in Punjab get affected due to red rot diseases. According to a survey conducted by Punjab government some areas of Gurdaspur, Hoshiarpur, Amritsar, Jalandhar, Pathankot have witnessed the red rot diseases in the sugarcane crop. About 50,000-acre area in 36 villages in Mukerian, Pathankot, Shri Hargobindpur, Gurdaspur, Kahnuwan, Narto Jaimal Singh, Ajnala and Ludhiana has been affected.
- Haryana government has increased the sugarcane price to Rs. 362 per quintal. Punjab and Haryana government has increased the Sugarcane price from Rs. 310/quintal to Rs. 360/ quintal in Punjab and from Rs. 350/ quintal to Rs. 362 per quintal in Haryana.

Technical Analysis - Sugar (M grade) Spot Market at Kolhapur market

- The sugar spot prices at the benchmark Kolhapur market was higher during last week and ended at Rs.3500/q.
- The next resistance and support level for the next week is expected at Rs.3580 and Rs.3200 per quintal respectively.

International Market Highlights

Recent Updates:

According to Covrig analytics, Sugar output in Brazil's center south region is expected to increase from 33.06 million tonnes to 34.17 million tonnes in 2022-23 season. As per the analysis, the sugarcane crop in Brazil's CS region would increase from 532 million tonnes to 552 million tonnes in the next season. Whereas, the sugarcane output in Brazil this season is likely to fall by 12%, lowest in the decade, due to unfavorable climatic conditions like drought and frost that have affected the sugarcane crop.

Previous Updates

• Bangladesh has fixed the Maximum retail price of sugar at TK 75 per kg. The prices of packed sugar were fixed at TK 75 per kg and loose sugar at TK 74 per kg. Despite the government has fixed the maximum retail price of sugar the prices of sugar in the domestic market continue to increase, the sugar is sold at TK 80-88 per kg in the retail market.



- Fiji sugar production has reached 60,000 tonnes. According to the Fiji Sugar Corporation (FSC) sugar mills have crushed around 700,000 tonnes of cane and produced 60,000 tonnes of sugar so far. Despite the Covid pandemic challenges the sugar production is increasing in Fiji, the Labasa mill is leading the sugar production by supplying more than 250,000 tonnes of cane and producing 24,000 tonnes of sugar.
- According to the International Sugar Organization (ISO), the global sugar deficit in the 2021-22 sugar season is forecasted to be 3.8 million tonnes. ISO in its May report predicted the global sugar deficit to be 2 million tonnes but due to the unfavorable conditions in major sugar-producing countries led to an increase in sugar deficit to 3.8 million tonnes. It has also stated that the sugar production is rising by 0.2% to 170.6 million tonnes in the forthcoming season as against the consumption is increasing by 1.6% to 174.5.
- Pakistan Trading Corporation has issued a tender to purchase 200,000 tonnes of white sugar. An international tender has been issued by the Trading Corporation of Pakistan and the deadline for submission of price offers is 24th August 2021. The tender has been issued to increase the sugar supply in the country to meet the domestic demand and arrest the rising prices. Earlier, the Economic Coordination Committee (ECC) has approved an increase in rates of sugar, ghee, and wheat flour at Utility Stores Corporation of Pakistan in July 2021. Sugar prices in Pakistan after that had reached to Rs. 80- 100 per kg from Rs. 68-85 per kg in all the major markets.




