Price Outlook:


The food ministry on 24th September 2021 under a notification has allocated an additional 2.5 LMT of monthly sales quota for September 2021 Sugar production for 2020-21 seasons are estimated at 309 lakh tonnes. Maharashtra Sugar mills will start the cane crushing operation from 15th October 2021. The average sugar prices have slightly decreased at Rs. 3623/q from the previous week at Rs.3563/q in Delhi market. The prices in Maharashtra stood high at Rs.3500/q.

Price Projection for the Next week

As per the Agriwatch estimates, spot sugar prices (M grade) in the benchmark Kolhapur market are likely to remain steady and in range next week between Rs.3450 -3550 per quintal for next week.

Domestic Sugar Market Summary

Average prices for sugar 'M' grade in key Kolhapur market were range boundatRs.3500per quintal, while in Shamli district there were no arrivals during the last week.



Domestic Market Highlights

Recent Updates:

• The food Ministry has allocated an additional 2.5 LMT monthly sugar sales quota for September month. The food ministry on 24th September 2021 under a notification has allocated an additional 2.5 LMT of monthly sales quota for September 2021 as due to good sugar demand in September 2021 and to ensure sufficient availability of sugar for domestic consumption. Earlier, the food ministry has allocated 22 LMT quota to 558 sugar mills in September 2021. Traders in the domestic market are afraid as the sugar prices may come down sharply after the food ministry decision. Sugar prices have reached a high after 7 months and are currently ranging between Rs. 3500- Rs. 3600 per quintal.

Previous Updates

- Indian Sugar Mills are holding on signing new sugar export contracts for the coming season 2021-22. As the domestic sugar prices are increasing in the local market Indian sugar mills are holding off on signing new export contracts. The rise in prices has widened the gap between local and global sugar rates. Although, Indian sugar mills have exported around 7.5 million tonnes of sugar during the current 2020-21 season and have also signed 1.2 million tonnes of export contract so far for the coming 2021-22 season.
- According to the Ministry of Agriculture and farmer's welfare, India's food grain production in Kharif 2021-22 seasons has estimated at a record of 150.5 million tonnes. Last year's Kharif production was estimated at 149.56 million tonnes for 2020-21 seasons. Among the Cash crops, Sugar production for this year is likely to increase to 5 percent at 419.25 MT.
- Government has cleared sugar export subsidy of Rs. 1,800 crore. According to the senior food ministry official, about Rs. 3,500 crore budgets was earlier allocated towards export subsidy for the 2020-21 season. Out of which Rs. 1,800 crore had been spent on clearing the subsidy claims, the balance subsidy will be paid to the mills soon. The mills have already exported the entire 6 million tonnes of quota during the current season.
- West Bengal has received 15 proposals to produce ethanol. West Bengal government aims to increase ethanol production in the state by setting up new plants to achieve the target of blending ethanol with petrol set by the centre. The state so far has received 15 proposals to produce ethanol. The total investment involved is Rs. 2,666 crore and around 4,000 direct employment is expected through this in the state.

Technical Analysis - Sugar (M grade) Spot Market at Kolhapur market

- The sugar spot prices at the benchmark Kolhapur market was higher during last week and ended at Rs.3500/q.
- The next resistance and support level for the next week is expected at Rs.3580 and Rs.3200 per quintal respectively.
- RSI is in the neutral region.

International Market Highlights

Recent Updates:

Malaysia sugar demand has increased by 5-10 percent in the first half of 2021. Due to ease in the lockdown restrictions and industries continuing to open, the sugar demand had picked up by 5-10 percent in the first half of this year and is expected to increase further in the second half of 2021. Earlier the pandemic has impacted the sugar consumption in Malaysia lowering the consumption from 1.5 million tonnes to 1.2 -1.3 million tonnes.

Previous Updates

- According to Covrig analytics, Sugar output in Brazil's center south region is expected to increase from 33.06 million tonnes to 34.17 million tonnes in 2022-23 season. As per the analysis, the sugarcane crop in Brazil's CS region would increase from 532 million tonnes to 552 million tonnes in the next season. Whereas, the sugarcane output in Brazil this season is likely to fall by 12%, lowest in the decade, due to unfavorable climatic conditions like drought and frost that have affected the sugarcane crop.
- Bangladesh has fixed the Maximum retail price of sugar at TK 75 per kg. The prices of packed sugar were fixed at TK 75 per kg and loose sugar at TK 74 per kg. Despite the government has fixed the maximum retail price of sugar the prices of sugar in the domestic market continue to increase, the sugar is sold at TK 80-88 per kg in the retail market.
- Fiji sugar production has reached 60,000 tonnes. According to the Fiji Sugar Corporation (FSC) sugar mills have crushed around 700,000 tonnes of cane and produced 60,000 tonnes of sugar so far. Despite the Covid pandemic challenges the sugar production is increasing in Fiji, the Labasa mill is leading the sugar production by supplying more than 250,000 tonnes of cane and producing 24,000 tonnes of sugar.
- According to the International Sugar Organization (ISO), the global sugar deficit in the 2021-22 sugar season is forecasted to be 3.8 million tonnes. ISO in its May report predicted the global sugar deficit to be 2 million tonnes but due to the unfavorable conditions in major sugar-producing countries led to an increase in sugar deficit to 3.8 million tonnes. It has also stated that the sugar production is rising by 0.2% to 170.6 million tonnes in the forthcoming season as against the consumption is increasing by 1.6% to 174.5.
- Pakistan Trading Corporation has issued a tender to purchase 200,000 tonnes of white sugar. An international tender has been issued by the Trading Corporation of Pakistan and the deadline for submission of price offers is 24th August 2021. The tender has been issued to increase the sugar supply in the country to meet the domestic demand and arrest the rising prices. Earlier, the Economic Coordination Committee (ECC) has approved an increase in rates of sugar, ghee, and wheat flour at Utility Stores Corporation of Pakistan in July 2021. Sugar prices in Pakistan after that had reached to Rs. 80- 100 per kg from Rs. 68-85 per kg in all the major markets.




International Sugar Futures Price Projection


