Domestic Market Highlights

Recent Updates:

According to the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare data, till 12th August 2022, the area under sugarcane cultivation has reached 55.20 lakh hectares as compared to 54.52 lakh hectares during the previous season. The area under sugarcane cultivation is expected to increase in the 2022-23 season, in Uttar Pradesh sowing has been completed on 23.60 lakh hectares, while in Maharashtra around 12.70 lakh hectares is sown and in Karnataka around 6.34 lakh hectares is under sugarcane cultivation. The major reason behind the expected increase in acreages is good rains and adequate water availability in the key producing states along with assured returns as compared to other competing crops.

According to the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare Fourth Advance estimate, total sugarcane production in India for the 2021-22 season is expected to be at 4318.12 lakh tonnes as compared to the previous season of 4054 lakh tones in the 2020-21 season. As per Agriwatch, the increase in production was from Maharashtra and Karnataka. Also, good rains earlier in the season has resulted in better yield in the 2021-22 season.

As of 10th Aug 2022, Telangana Sugarcane sowing has reached 24,609 acres for the 2022-23 season which is slightly lower compared to the previous season's sowing of 31,485 acres. Average rainfall for the period from 01.06.2022 to 10.08.2022 has reached 806 mm higher as compared to the previous season of 559 mm.

As during the last week, the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs has approved Fair and Remunerative Price (FRP) of sugarcane for the 2022-23 sugar season at Rs. 305 per quintal. The Sugar millers from Uttar Pradesh have started demanding a hike in state-advised prices for sugarcane for the 2022-23 season. In the previous season, Uttar Pradesh government had released an FRP of Rs. 350 per quintal.

International Market Highlights

Previous Updates

- Brazil Sugar production is expected to fall in the coming 2022-23 season. Accordin to the Government, the sugarcane production for the 2022-23 season is projected to be 514 million tonnes in the centresouth (CS) region as against 525 million tonnes in the 2021-22 season. Farmers have switched to crops like soy and corn which are more profitable.
- According to the Pakistan Sugar Mills Association, around 1.2 million tonnes of excess sugar is available at the beginning of the next sugarcane crushing season. During the previous 2021-22 season sugar mills had produced 2 million tonnes of surplus sugar. As per the sources, it is expected that because of good weather conditions in this season the sugarcane crop is expected to increase by 10 percent in the 2022-23 season.
- Sugar beet production in Russia is likely to increase by 5 % against the previous season. The Sugar refineries have started processing sugar beet for this season. In the previous season Russia has produced



around 41.2 million tonnes of sugar beet. An increase in sugar beet production would help the country to meet the domestic demand as well as the demand of the neighboring countries.


Price Outlook:

• The average sugar prices were slightly lower at Rs. 3,528 per quintal during the past week from Rs.3,530 per quintal in Delhi market. Whereas, sugar prices in Maharashtra were stable at Rs.3519 per quintal.

• Agriwatch expects that spot Sugar prices (M grade) in the benchmark Kolhapur market is likely to range in between Rs.3480 -3580 per quintal. Average prices for Sugar 'M' grade in key Kolhapur market was higher at Rs.3500 per quintal due to improved festive demand.
