Domestic Market Highlights

Recent Updates:

Uttar Pradesh sugar mills had cleared around 97.40% of cane dues of the 2021-22 sugar season. The mills have cleared sugarcane dues of around Rs. 2892.32 crore against a total 2969.37 crore. Sugarcane crushing has also picked up for the 2022-23 season and around 3.6 lakh tonne of sugar has been produced till 15th November 2022.

As of 21st November 2022, Gujarat sugarcane sowing has reached 1,05,036 hectares for the 2022-23 season which is slightly higher compared to the previous season's sowing of 79,898 hectares. Good rainfall during the past month has resulted in an increase in acreages under the sugarcane crop.

As per the Indian sugar mills association, Sugar production in India has reached 19.9 lakh tonne as against 20.8 lakh tonne till 15th November 2022. The crushing operations were delayed this year because of rains during late October month and early November. The state-wise sugar production is mentioned below:

Sugar Exports:

Around 35 lakh tonnes of sugar exports contract have already been signed for the 2022-23 season. Out of which, 2 lakh tonne has been physically exported till October 2022 as compared to 4 lakh tonnes during the corresponding period last year. AgriWatch estimates sugar exports of around 75 lakh tonnes during the 2022-23 season lower from the previous 116 lakh tonne during 2021-22 season.

According to the Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT), around 5,841 MT (raw/refined) sugar is to be exported to European Union and about 8,606 Metric Tonne Raw Value (MTRV) raw cane sugar is to be exported to USA under Tariff rate quota (TRQ) scheme from 1st October, 2022, to 30th September, 2023.

The Indian Sugar Mills Association is expecting that the government may allow an additional 2-4 million tonne of sugar exports for the 2022-23 season. The government earlier approved 6 million tonne of sugar exports for the 2022-23 season. Overall sugar production in India during the 2022-23 season is expected to be 36 million tonne and ethanol about 5 million tonne.

Although, there are rumors in the market that around 45 lakh tonnes of sugar exports contracts are likely to get signed till December'22 by the exporters/millers.



International Market Highlights

Sugar prices have gained support after the Thai Sugar Milliers Corporation said that Thailand might push back the start of this year's sugar cane crushing season to early December from 23rd Nov'22 and reduce its sugarcane production estimate to 105 MMT from 110 MMT, citing unfavorable weather conditions. A bearish factor for sugar was from Czarnikow that Brazil's Center-South mills would produce 34.7 MMT of sugar in 2023-24 (Apr/Mar), up +7% year-on-year basis.

Sugar prices also saw pressure after the Organization of Cane Producers Association in Brazil forecasted Brazil's sugar output in 2022-23 season at 36.9 MMT due to favorable weather and that production would reach 37.2 MMT in 2023-24 season. As per Unica, Brazil's Center-South sugar output in October was estimated down -3.1% year-on-year basis at 30.281 MMT.

The Australian sugar crush is over 75% complete, with 25.4 million tonnes processed to date. Sugar Futures ended flat after a volatile week.

Pakistan Sugar Mills Association has urged the government to allow the export of surplus sugar. The millers are demanding to allow exports of around 60% of the surplus sugar stock else they would delay the crushing for the coming season. (The mills may start the can crushing operation in January 2023)

The International Sugar Organization, has forecasted that sugar production may increase by around +4.5% year on year basis to a 5-year high of 182.1 Million Tonne in 2022-23 season, as a result, global sugar market would be in a surplus of +5.6 MMT. However, higher sugar output in India is bearish for prices. India's Sugarcane acreages has increased by +5.4% year-on-year basis, and sugar production is expected to increase by +2.9% year-on-year basis to 35.8 MMT.

Jaggery:

Kolhapur: Jaggery auction has stopped in Kolhapur Agriculture Produce Market Committee (APMC) during the week under review as prices had again dropped sharply. The jaggery making farmers had refused to sell their produce unless the trader agreed to pay at least Rs. 3,700 per quintal for jaggery. However, as per sources the jaggery auction will resume in the coming week. The larger quantity of supply and the low demand across the country has led to a drop in the jaggery prices. Further, prices in the coming week are expected to rise as with the decreasing temperature jaggery demand is expected to improve.

Kerala: Alangadan jaggery is expected to come in market by the year 2024. Sugarcane farming will be done on 20 acres in Alangadan. The Order has also been placed with Sugarcane Breeding Institute Coimbatore to raise sampling which will be planted at Alangad. The planting will start from January next year. The Alangadan Jaggery is also planned for getting the GI tag for the product. The Alangadan jaggery has been used for making Aravana Payasam (Jaggery Kheer) in Sabarimala and for Aranmula.

Ethanol:

The Chhattisgarh government had signed two MoU (Memorandum of Understandings) at the Chhattisgarh Business Summit 2022. The MoU were signed for setting up an ethanol production plant and drone and UAV manufacturing unit.

According to the press release issued by the CMO, an MoU was signed between the state government and Rajesh Gautam of NKJ Biofuel, Durg for setting up an ethanol production plant in the cooperative sector with an investment of Rs 140 crores, while another MoU was inked with Manish Bajpai of Daybest Research Private Ltd for setting up 4500 drone and UAV manufacturing units at the investment of Rs 50.95 crore.

The government has released guidelines for producing ethanol from sugar and grain-based feedstocks in India. According to the new guidelines, the validating agencies will have to send a copy of the validation report to the directorate of sugar and vegetable oils, the department of food and public distribution and the ministry of petroleum and natural gas within a fortnight of undertaking the onsite validation.

- The guidelines issued encompass sugar/molasses-based ethanol distilleries and grain-based distilleries. These norms will help distilleries identify the quantity of ethanol produced from different routes.
- The quantity of ethanol produced by any of the routes should conform to the desired specifications as per IS 15465(22): Anhydrous ethanol for use in automotive fuel or as per the requirement of oil marketing companies. As specified in their tender document, the ethanol content percentage by volume shall not be below 99.6 at 15 degrees Celsius. These distilleries units shall be operated with one type of feedstock at a time.
- However, in case of ethanol unit having two identifiable processing streams, they may use a different class of feedstock for the two streams subject to proper recording of data of two streams with respect to quantities and qualities.
- The validating agency shall specify the loss in sugar recovery due to diversion, sugar recovery during the diversion and estimated sugar recovery, considering no diversion of juice/syrup or B,C Heavy molasses so as to facilitate the calculation of fair and remunerative price (FRP) for sugarcane.
