

#### Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

Wheat futures continue to recover as expected taking clue from firm cash market, strong inner tone and restricted supply from stockists. Fresh demand from local and South Indian millers remains supportive to the cash market fundamental. Rake loading from Kota region to Tamil Nadu and other South Indian states is being reported at Rs 1790/1800 per qtl.

**The CACP(Commission for Agricultural Costs and Prices)** has recommended to hike wheat MSP by 5.17 percent from Rs 1450 to Rs 1525 per qtl for wheat to be marketed in MY2016-17. In general Agriculture Ministry accepts CACP recommendation. However, ministry will prepare a cabinet note after taking suggestion from states and other ministries.

Wheat export during the week ending 20th Sep-15 was registered at 536.62 tonne at an average FoB quote of \$286.02 per tonne. Major buyers were Bahrain, UAE, Malaysia and Nepal. As parity is not in favour of India export volume is unlikely to increase in the coming weeks. Russia and US continue to offer wheat at cheaper rates. There is no import this week.

Agricultural Statistics Division, Directorate of Economics & Statistics (DES) has released First Adv. Estimate for kharif crop for 2015-16 on 16th Sept,2015. Production target for wheat in Rabi has been set at 94.75 lakh tonne. In fourth adv. estimate it has revised wheat production estimate for 2014-15 to 90.78 lakh tonne. Notably, India has produced 95.85 million tonne wheat in 2013-14.

Wheat stock in central pool was registered at 344.74 lakh tonne as on 01.09.2015. Stock in transit was reported at around 3.46 lakh tonne while wheat lying in mandis was registered at 0.45 lakh tonne. As on first October India requires 175.20 lakh tonne as buffer stock while 30 lakh tonne as reserve stock. In Sept 2014 central pool stock was registered at 351.72 lakh tonne. It is 1.98 percent lower than the available stock in Sept, 2014.

**Total wheat procurement was registered at 280.88 lakh tonne as** on 14.07.2015 as against 271.66 lakh tonne during same period last year. Punjab has contributed 103.44 lakh tonne so far, followed by Haryana 67.78 lakh tonne. M.P. contribution stands at around 73.09 lakh tonne. Rajasthan has procured only13.0 lakh tonne. Overall procurement is up by 3.39 percent this year.

## **International Market Update:**

**IGC** has revised wheat production estimate by 7 million tonne to 727 MMT on the basis of improved production prospects in Russian Ukraine, Australia and EU.It might be a final production estimate for the year. Previously IGC had increased production estimate from 710 to 720 MMT.

Wheat FoB quotes in Russia improved around \$2 per tonne in anticipation of wheat export tax cut and govt 's plant to procure wheat at higher price. Decision on tax cut is expected by the end of the month. Wheat having 12.5 percent protein content quoted at \$182 per tonne free-on-board (FOB) at the end of last week, up \$2 from a week earlier. Currently, export tax is set at 50 percent of the customs price minus 5,500 roubles (\$83) per tonne, but not less than 50 roubles a Ton. Now limit may be raised from 5500 to 6500 rouble per ton

Indonesia is the biggest buyers of Australian wheat (25 percent of total wheat export) and is expected to continue its status as the biggest buyer in 2015-16 too. Australia received an order of supplying 1.10 lakh tonne feed grade wheat from Philippines. Almost 55000 tonne has been prices at \$210.90 Per Tonne on c & f basis and the rest at \$213.75 per T.

**Domestic market Outlook**: Wheat cash market is likely stay steady to slightly firm.
