

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

New wheat is ruling around Rs 1475 to Rs 1500 per qtl. in loose. Faq variety in mandi is being traded at Rs 1510 to Rs 1550 per qtl. Price may recover from this level with the commencement of govt.'s procurement at Rs 1525 per qtl.and likely rains that may delay harvesting activities. Delayed harvesting and likely bad weather may harm standing crop ready to be harvested. Flattening of crop and water lodging may affect wheat quality and yield too. So remaining weeks of march and first fortnight of April would remain crucial for the final size of the crop.

All India wheat ave price decreases by1.84 % from Rs 1682.34 to Rs 1651.2 per qtl. during the week ended 15th March-2016.Wheat prices declined by 4.82 % during last two weeks. It is lower by5.74 % from the average price registered in Mid March-2015.Major decline was seen in States like Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra and Orissa

New wheat in MP, Rajasthan and Gujarat are being traded at Rs1500,Rs 1490 andRs 1510 per qtl respectively while arrival were reported at 8000,2000and 4000 bags a day. Quality is good so far. Pressure may build up by end March..Rake loading for south India from Kota region of Rajasthan is being reported at Rs 1870 per qtl.New wheat (FAQ) in Kota is being traded in the range of Rs 1500 to Rs 1650 per qtl.

Despite disparity India exported 570.8tonne wheat during week ended 6thMar-2016 against 772tonne previous week ending 28th...It has been exported at an aveFoB of \$285.02 per tonne. Buyers for the Indian wheat are UAE, Kuwait, Malaysia and Somalia. As prices are ruling higher in domestic market, export pace would remain slow despite new crop being round the corner as global wheat markets offer wheat at very attractive price. There is no import last week.

Agricultural Statistics Division, Directorate of Economics & Statistics (DES) has released Second Adv. Estimate for Rabi crop for 2015-16 on 15th Feb, 2016. Production target for wheat in Rabi had been set at 94.75 lakh tonne. Now in Second Adv. estimate it has estimated wheat production for 2015-16 at 93.82 lakh tonne. Notably, India has produced 86.53 million tonne wheat in 2014-15.

The govt. sets wheat procurement target at 30MMT for RMS 2016-17, almost same as last year. It was decided to procure 300 lakh tons (It) of wheat during RMS 2016-17. The actual procurement of wheat during RMS 2015-16 was 280.88 It, inspite of wheat crop getting affected due to untimely rains and hailstorms during last March-April.

Agriwatch has revised wheat production estimate up by 4.26 MMT from 85.32 MMT to 89.58 MMT for 2016-17 MY starting from April-2016. Temperature in Feb & March may affect yield where wheat has been sown late. Carryout for 2016-17 would decrease from 15.38 to 13.96 MMT, the lowest in seven years.

International Market Update:

.**IGC revised wheat production estimate up by 1MMT to732 MMT this month**. Trade estimate too has not been revised and it stayed steady at 152 MMT. Consumption has been pegged at 719 MMT in the month of Feb 2016.Carryout stock has been pegged at 213MMT.

Egypt buys 1.2 lakh tonne wheat from France,60,000 T from Romania and 60,000 T from Ukraine through tender at \$188.27 on CiF basis. Seller was casillo.FoB quote for this wheat was \$178.87 per tonne.Amepora and Dreyfus sold Romanian and Ukrariuan (60,000 each) wheat at \$188.77 and \$189.93 per T on CiF basis. FoB quote for this wheat were \$183 & \$180 per tonne. Wheat would be delivered in mid April-2016.

Domestic market Outlook: Wheat cash market is likely trade steady to slightly weak.
