## Wheat Daily Fundamental Report 03 June, 2016

#### **Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:**

All India average monthly price decreased by1.61 percent from Rs 1734( in April) to Rs 1706.06 per qtl in May-2016 despite tight supply side and private trades active buying. As supply side is tight and private holding/retention is considered to be 10 to 15 percent higher this year, prices of wheat is bound to go up in next quarter, starting from July-2016. There is a wide gap on production estimates and it has encouraged retention tendency at farmers and stockist's level. Lower procurement, higher prevailing price and prevailing gossip in market hint towards lower than normal production. Controversy on production size may continue as there is a huge difference on yield front. Agriwatch will revise its wheat production estimate in July-2016.

**Govt. may use two tools to curb wheat market if price continues to move up.** Firstly, it can revise sale price for OMSS in July and secondly, revise import duty downward from 25 % to 10 %.. It has ample stock to take care of any additional demand despite lower procurement. Revising import duty downward may push global wheat price up. Dollar may appreciate.

This year overall arrival has been registered at 25.29MMT against 30.49MMT last year till date. The difference is over 5 MMT. Lower procurement is expected to drive down central pool stock near minimum required buffer stock norms in fourth quarter of this MY. The only silver lining is possibility of good rainfall that may increase area next season.

The pace of wheat Procurement has slowed down due to decreased arrivals and higher prevailing prices in domestic market. Indian procurement agencies have procured 224.81 lakh tonne till 13th, May-2016. Punjab and Haryana have procured 106 & 67.68 lakh tonne so far. MP has contributed 6.78 lakh tonne while Rajasthan has procured 6.66 lakh tonne so far.

Agricultural Statistics Division, Directorate of Economics & Statistics (DES) has released Third Adv. Estimate for Rabi crop for 2015-16 on 9th May, 2016. Production target for wheat in Rabi had been set at 94.75 lakh tonne for 2015-16 crop year. Now in Third Adv. estimate wheat production estimate has been revised up from 93.82 lakh tonne to 94.04 MMT.

#### **International Market Update:**

**Thailand last week bought 60,000 tonnes of Black Sea feed wheat** for \$187 a tonne, including cost and freight, for August shipment. Most feed makers are taking Ukrainian shipments, although some Argentinean and French cargoes have also made their way to Asia.

IGC has revised global wheat production estimate up from 717 to 722 MMT in Its May-2016 update. Global trade estimate has been revised up by 1 MMT to 154MMT. Global consumption estimate has been revised up by 2MMT to 717 MMT. Carryout stock has been revised up from 218 to 223 MMT.

**Russia will procure wheat for restocking programme in MY 2016-17 ,starting from July** at \$161 per T(10,900 roubles) for third class wheat,almost same priceset for last year. At the end of last week, domestic prices for third-class wheat were at 10,925 roubles a tonne in the European part of Russia on an ex-works basis

Wheat export from Ukraine may touch15.6 MMT this year and total grain export is expected to reach a high of38 MMT. Maize share in export is19.5 MMT. Season will end in July this year. In 2015 total grain production was pegged at60MMT. This year grain export has increased by 5 MMT in comparison to last year.

Domestic market Outlook: Wheat cash market is likely trade steady to slightly weak in the short term.
