

### Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

All India average wheat price increased by 2.50 % from Rs1775.04to Rs1869.70 per qtl. during the week ended 11<sup>th</sup> June-2016. Arrival continues to decrease and private buyers remain active above Rs 1700-Rs1725 per qtl. All India average price is higher by 8.31% in comparison to price registered in June, 2015. In June, 2015 average price was registered at 1680.91 per qtl. Overall trend in cash market is expected to remain firm as lower production this year has changed inner tone. Govt. has estimated 94.02MMT wheat production in 3<sup>rd</sup> Adv. estimates released on 9<sup>th</sup> May-2016.However, lower arrivals and higher price in ongoing season hint lower production size (around 87MMT) in 2016.

India can import 5 million tonnes of wheat in 2016/17 as its local production is hit by back-to-back years of drought amid rising demand. Says ITC, a bulk consumer of wheat in India. Wheat production is expected to be in the range of 85 to 87 MMT this year.

**Govt.'s procurement target for the year is unchanged at 30 MMT and there is no** reduction in its target so far despite slower pace of procurement in Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh. Procurement has been below 23 MMT so far. There is a gossip in the market that higher prevailing price in open market and thinning arrival may restrict total procurement to24MMT for the ongoing season. Despite lower production govt. has sufficient stock to take care of market need. Besides, option for import and revision in import duty remain open.

Agriwatch expects revision in import duty soon. Govt. may revise it down from 25 to 10 % to restrict uptrend. At current price Indian wheat FoB, if sourced from MP,Rajasthan for Kandlaport, comes to \$275/276 per metric tonne. In INR term is Rs 18500 per tonne. At current price if Russian wheat is imported it may land at Indian port at \$245 per tonne with 10 % import duty. At 25 % it would be \$306.88 per T. If wheat is imported from France costing comes to\$297 At 25% duty, it comes to \$238.06 at 10 % duty. At 10 % duty Australian wheat costing at Indian port would be \$264.24 per Tonne.If govt. revises duty to 10 percent, parity would turn in favor of south Indian millers.

**Govt.** has estimated 94.02MMT wheat production in 3<sup>rd</sup> Adv. estimates released on 9<sup>th</sup> May-2016. However, lower arrivals and higher price in ongoing season hint lower production size (around 87/88MMT) in 2016.

#### **International Market Update:**

**Bangladesh received a lowest offer of \$233.17 a tonne from Singapore-based** Agro Food in a tender to import 50,000 tonnes of wheat. Only one other trader, Olam International, competed for the tender from the Directorate General of Food, quoting \$249.89 a tonne.

Wheat production in Australia for the 2016-2017 season (October-September) is expected to reach as high as 27.1 million mt, if La Nina occurs with 20% above-average rainfall in the country, said National Bank of Australia

*IGC has revised global wheat production estimate up from 717 to 722 MMT* in Its May-2016 update. Global trade estimate has been revised up by 1 MMT to 154MMT.

**Russia will procure wheat for restocking programme in MY 2016-17 , starting from July** at \$161 per *T*(10,900 roubles) for third class wheat, almost same priceset for last year. At the end of last week, domestic prices for third-class wheat were at 10,925 roubles a tonne in the European part of Russia on an ex-works basis.

**Domestic market Outlook**: Wheat cash market is likely trade range bound in the short term..
