

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

As per latest update, wheat stock in central pool as on 1st Feb'17 stood at 11.52 MMT down by 16.16% compared to last month. This is the lowest quantity recorded in the last ten years. For the year 2016-17, FCI has sold around 43.31 lakh tonnes of wheat until third week of February. Of this total quantity around 36.80 lakh tonnes has been purchased by private trade and the remaining quantity by state governments. As per second advance estimate for 2016-17 wheat production is likely to be around 96.6 MMT and the procurement target has been fixed at 33 MMT higher by ten percent compared to last year

Government has fixed wheat procurement target at 33MMT for 2017-18. Of the total target around 11.5 MMT will be procured from Punjab, 8.5 MMT from Madhya Pradesh, 7.5 MMT from Haryana, 3MMT from Uttar Pradesh and 1.7 MMT from Rajasthan. Government target procurement for MY 2016-17 was 30.5 MMT against which it procured only 22.96 MMT. Wheat production target is kept at 96.5 MMT for 2016-17.

All India weekly average prices increased by 0.65 percent to Rs. 1974.19 per quintal during the week ended 15th February 2017. Wheat average price were ruling at Rs 1961.4 per quintal during 01-08th February 2017. As compared to prices in the week 09-15 February 2016, the prices are firm by 13.44 percent. Prices are expected to remain range bound to slightly weak in coming days.

As per second advance estimate for 2016-17 wheat production is likely to be around 96.6 MMT which is higher compared to fourth advance estimate of 93.5 MMT issued in 2015-16. This year overall acreage is higher by around 4.5% over normal acreage of 304.05 lakh hectares.

Wheat WPI has decreased slightly from 251.7 in December'16 to 250.3 in January-2017. Monthly wheat inflation has decreased by 0.55 percent in January-17 compared to December-16. As compared to January-16, wheat WPI has increased by around 9.49% and by 5.54% compared to January-2015.

As per latest update, FCI has sold around 85 Thousand tonnes of wheat in the second week of February compared to 88 thousand tonnes in the first week. In January FCI has sold around 3.41 lakh tonnes and 4.25 lakh tonnes in December. For the year 2016-17, FCI has sold around 42.49 lakh tonnes of wheat until second week of February. Of this total quantity around 36.05 lakh tonnes has been purchased by private trade and the remaining quantity by state governments.

According to latest update, area sown until 03 February'17 is 317.81 lakh hectares compared to 297.25 lakh hectares in the previous Rabi season. Among various states the area is down in Jammu & Kashmir and Karnataka, whereas Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh have seen an increase in area compared to last year for the same date. The normal area is 304.05 lakh hectares. Area is expected to be higher this year as government has increased MSP of wheat which has motivated farmers to sow more area.

As per latest update, India is expected to receive around 1MMT of wheat in January'17. This will include delayed shipments from last year as well as shipments that were booked for this month only. This may lead to congestion at Indian ports. Around 700,000 tonnes is expected from Ukraine and the remaining from Australia for the month. Furthermore Indian crop has entered crucial stages and any further deals will depend on how the crop shapes up. As of now, not many new deals are being signed.

International Market Update:

Philippines have bought around 54000 tonnes of Australian wheat to be delivered in June and July. Australian standard wheat (ASW) was bought for \$205-210 per tonne including cost and freight. Australia with a record crop of around 35 MMT is providing wheat at competitive prices. Philippines monthly requirement is around 800000 tonnes and it is yet to cover half of its requirement for the month of May.

GASC has purchased 360000 tonnes of Russian, Ukrainian and Romanian wheat through tender after abolishing its zerotolerance policy towards ergot. AOS offered 60000 tonnes Russian wheat at FOB \$195.0/tonne, Daewoo offered 60000 tonnes Russian wheat at FOB of \$196.0/tonne, Grainbow offered 60000 tonnes Russian wheat at FOB \$196.0/tonne, Louis Dreyfus offered 60000 tonnes Ukrainian wheat at FOB \$195.5/tonne, Nidera offered 60000 tonnes Romanian wheat at FOB \$197.5/tonne and Aston offered 60000 tonnes Russian wheat at FOB \$197/tonne.

As per latest update, Ethiopia has bought 400000 tonnes of wheat in three consignments of 133333 tonnes each. The first consignment was purchased by promising international at \$227.85 C&F scheduled for delivery in March, second consignment was purchased by ADM at \$227.5 C&F scheduled for delivery in April and third consignment was purchased by Phoenix at \$225.10 C&F scheduled for delivery in May.

Outlook: Cash market is expected to trade steady to slightly weak in the near term.
