

### Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

Wheat arrivals in the mandis of Haryana touched 26.82 lakh tonne so far.Out of total26.82 lakh tonne 26.81 lakh tonne has been purchased by five govt.'s agencies active in the state. Private trades have purchased only536 tonne .Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Department and HAFED have procured 6.70& 8.79 lakh tonne respectively so far. FCI has procured3.25 lakh tonne. Haryana Warehousing Corporation has procured5.77 lakh tonne and Haryana Agro purchased 2.29 lakh tonne wheat so far.

Government agencies have started procurement since 15th March'17. Until 12th April'17 government has procured around 39 lakh tonnes of wheat compared to 36 lakh tonnes during the same period last year. Of the total quantity procured, around 21 lakh tonnes has been procured from Madhya Pradesh, 14.9 lakh tonnes from Haryana, 2.5 lakh tonnes from Punjab, 50000 tonnes from Rajasthan and 11883 tonnes from Uttar Pradesh. In Rabi marketing season 2017-18 government has set procurement target of 33 MMT.

As per latest update, until yesterday Traders and five government agencies have purchased a total of 14.95 lakh tonnes of wheat at MSP. Of the total quantity procured by government agencies around 3.75 lakh tonnes has been procured by food, civil supplies and consumer affairs department, 4.45 lakh tonnes by HAFED, 2.15 lakh tonnes by FCI, 1.12 lakh tonnes by Haryana Agro Industries corporation and 3.46 lakh tonnes by Haryana warehousing corporation. Government has kept a target of 75 lakh tonnes for 2017-18.

As per latest circular released by NCDEX transaction charges on list A commodities has been increased and they will be in effect from 17Th April'17. List A commodities include Wheat, Guar seed, Guar gum, Soybean, coriander, sugar, etc. Furthermore castor seed will also be moved from list B to list A from 17th April. Transaction charges for list B and C commodities shall be charged at a flat rate of Rs 2 per lakh of trade and Rs 0.10 per lakh of trade respectively.

All India weekly average prices decreased by 1.51 percent to Rs. 1852.57 per quintal during the week ended 08th April 2017. Wheat average price were ruling at Rs 1881.04 per quintal during 24-31 March 2017. As compared to prices in the week 01-08 April 2016, the prices are firm by 8.27 percent. Prices are expected to remain range bound to slightly weak in coming days.

Indian flour millers have purchased around 150000 tonnes of Australian wheat with protein content of 9 percent for May shipment. The said quantity was purchased at \$220-221 per tonne including cost and freight. India has imposed 10 percent import duty but even after that Australian wheat is cheaper for mills in south India.

Government has imposed 10 percent import duty on 28th March'17. However this was not able to cease flow of imports and millers are still importing wheat. As per latest update millers have purchased 150000 tonnes of Australian wheat for May shipment. Agriwatch recommends duty of 25 percent to halt imports completely.

As per market sources wheat stock in central pool as on 16th March'17 is 8.57 MMT, which is lowest in last ten years. Due to lower production in the last two years government has to increase its release in OMSS to keep the prices under control which led to lower stocks. Last marketing season government was able to procure only 22.9 MMT. As good crop is expected this year, Government has kept a target of 33 MMT in current marketing season.

According to latest update, area sown until 03 February'17 is 317.81 lakh hectares compared to 297.25 lakh hectares in the previous Rabi season. Among various states the area is down in Jammu & Kashmir and Karnataka, whereas Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh have seen an increase in area compared to last year for the same date. The normal area is 304.05 lakh hectares. Area is expected to be higher this year as government has increased MSP of wheat which has motivated farmers to sow more area.

#### International Market Update:

As per latest update, around 89 percent of soft wheat is in good or excellent condition compared to 90 percent a week earlier. Warm and dry weather has helped sowing of spring crops however it has raised concern about low moisture levels.

As per latest update, Japan's ministry of agriculture bought 126405 MMT of food quality wheat from United States, Australia and Canada. Around 68095 MMT has been bought from United States with minimum protein content of 14 percent to be loaded between May 21-June 20, 24190 MMT has been bought from Canada with minimum protein content of 13.5 percent to be loaded between June 21- July 20 and 34120 MMT from west Australia to be loaded between June 1-June 20.

**South Korea's Feed Leader committee purchased around 63000 tonnes of feed wheat** in a private deal at \$187.2 per tonne cost and freight. The wheat should be delivered around September. An additional cost of \$1.25 per tonne is also applicable for port unloading. The deal was made after NOFI purchased 65000 tonnes last week.

Outlook: Cash market is expected to trade steady to slightly weak in the near term.
