

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

Government may not increase import duty to 25% and keep it unchanged at 10% as it is expecting a production of 96.6 million tonnes. At prevailing duty of 10%, Indian flour millers are still importing wheat from Australia. Around 150000 tonnes of Australian wheat has been purchased for May shipment with a protein content of 9% at \$220-221 per tonne cost & freight.

As per latest update wheat arrival in Punjab and Haryana has crossed 100 lakh tonnes. Wheat arrival of around 51 lakh tonnes has been recorded in Punjab and around 50.5 lakh tonnes in Haryana. Government procured 67.52 lakh tonnes and 106.49 lakh tonnes in Haryana and Punjab respectively during last marketing season. For current marketing season government has kept a target of 115 lakh tonnes for Punjab and 75 lakh tonnes for Haryana.

Government agencies have started procurement since 15th March'17. Until 18th April'17 government has procured around 119.07 lakh tonnes of wheat compared to 104.68 lakh tonnes during the same period last year. Of the total quantity procured, around 30.55 lakh tonnes has been procured from Madhya Pradesh compared to 28.29 lakh tonnes last year, 47.16 lakh tonnes from Haryana compared to 44.56 lakh tonnes last year, 37.42 lakh tonnes from Punjab compared to 30.81 lakh tonnes last year, 2.31 lakh tonnes from Rajasthan, 1.56 lakh tonnes from Uttar Pradesh and 2000 tonnes from Gujarat. In Rabi marketing season 2017-18 government has set procurement target of 33 MMT.

Wheat WPI has decreased from 247.7 in February to 238.8 in March-2017. Monthly wheat inflation has decreased by 3.59 percent in March-17 compared to February-17. As compared to March-16, wheat WPI has increased by around 4.65% and by 10.81% compared to February -2015.

All India weekly average prices decreased by 2.24 percent to Rs. 1811.13 per quintal during the week ended 15th April 2017. Wheat average price were ruling at Rs 1852.57 per quintal during 01-08 April 2017. As compared to prices in the week 09-15 April 2016, the prices are firm by 4.83 percent. Prices are expected to remain range bound to slightly weak in coming days.

As per latest update, until 16th April around 37.15 lakh tonnes have arrived in Haryana. Traders and five government agencies have purchased 3000 tonnes and 37.12 lakh tonnes of wheat. Of the total quantity procured by government agencies around 9.36 lakh tonnes has been procured by food, civil supplies and consumer affairs department, 12.54 lakh tonnes by HAFED, 4.25 lakh tonnes by FCI, 3.09 lakh tonnes by Haryana Agro Industries corporation and 7.58 lakh tonnes by Haryana warehousing corporation. Highest arrivals were recorded in Kaithal (4.71 lakh tonnes) and Karnal (4.61 lakh tonnes) districts.

According to latest update, area sown until 03 February'17 is 317.81 lakh hectares compared to 297.25 lakh hectares in the previous Rabi season. Among various states the area is down in Jammu & Kashmir and Karnataka, whereas Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh have seen an increase in area compared to last year for the same date. The normal area is 304.05 lakh hectares. Area is expected to be higher this year as government has increased MSP of wheat which has motivated farmers to sow more area.

International Market Update:

As per latest update, Japan's ministry of agriculture bought 95555 MMT of food quality wheat from United States and Canada. Around 70275 MMT has been bought from United States with protein content of 14 percent to be loaded between May 21-June 20 and 25280 MMT of western red spring wheat has been bought from Canada with minimum protein content of 13.5 percent to be loaded between June 21- July 20.

Farmers in Argentina are likely to sow around 5.5 million hectares in upcoming season 2017-18. Argentina is likely to harvest 17.5 million tonnes in 2017-18 season compared to 16.3 million tonnes in 2016-17. Sowing of wheat has increased since government has removed export taxes in 2015. Wheat is planted in Argentina during June-July and harvested in December-January.

South Korea's largest feedmaker Nonghyup feed incorporation purchased around 55000 tonnes of feed wheat. The said quantity is likely to arrive around 25th August and was purchased at \$192.74 per tonne cost & freight plus \$1.25 per tonne for port unloading.

As per latest update released by U.S. department of agriculture around 8% of winter wheat is in excellent condition, 46% in good condition, 33% in fair condition and around 13% in poor condition. Furthermore around 13% of spring wheat has been planted compared to 25% last year.

Russian wheat export prices remained flat as rouble increased by 1.6 percent against dollar. Black sea prices for Russian wheat with a protein content of 12.5% for April delivery settled at \$188 per tonne FoB. The price for May delivery was quoted at \$187 per tonne. Russia has exported 22.6 MMT of wheat between 1st July'16 and 13th April'17.

Outlook: Cash market is expected to trade steady to slightly weak in the near term.
