### Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

FCI will sell a total quantity 800500 tonnes of wheat in different states through e-auction on 17th July at a reserve price of Rs 1790 per quintal. Of the total quantity in OMSS, highest quantity of 262000 tonnes is offered in Maharashtra followed by 173000 tonnes in Haryana, 60000 tonnes in West Bengal, 55650 tonnes in Punjab, 50000 tonnes in M.P, 30000 tonnes in Odhisa, 29000 tonnes in Gujarat, 22750 tonnes in Karnataka, 20000 tonnes in Rajasthan, 17000 tonnes in Kerala, 16500 tonnes in Tamil Nadu, 16000 tonnes in Delhi, 10000 tonnes in Assam, 10000 tonnes in Chandigarh, 6000 tonnes in J&k,5600 tonnes in Uttarakhand, 5500 tonnes in Chhattisgarh, 5000 tonnes in Uttar Pradesh, 2000 tonnes in Goa, 1500 tonnes in Himachal Pradesh, 1000 tonnes in Jharkhand, 1000 tonnes in Pondicherry and 1000 tonnes in Andhra Pradesh.

As per latest update, India has exported 0.72 lakh tonnes of wheat in April-May 2017 compared to 1.09 lakh tonnes in April-May 2016. Whereas on the import front India has imported 2.18 lakh tonnes in April-May 2017 compared to 0.00 lakh tonnes in April-May 2016. Import is likely to be around 2-3 million tonnes in 2017-18 however, export will be lower due to higher domestic quotes compared to other major exporting countries.

All India weekly average prices increased by 1.45 percent to Rs. 1812.64 per quintal during the week ended 15th July 2017. Wheat average price were ruling at Rs 1786.77 per quintal during 01-08 July 2017. As compared to prices in the week 09th -15th July 2016, the prices are firm by 2.23 percent. Prices are expected to remain steady to firm in coming days.

As per latest update, wheat stock in central pool as on 1st July'17 stood at 32.27 MMT down by 3.48% compared to last month. This quantity is higher by around 20.94% compared to last year for the same month. For the year 2017-18, FCI has decided to sell around 40 lakh tonnes of wheat. As per third advance estimate for 2016-17 wheat production is likely to be around 97.4 MMT which is higher compared to second advance estimate of 96.6 MMT issued in February 2017.

Grain quality is better this year compared to last year and there are no issues relating to higher moisture and pest. This year overall acreage is higher by around 4.5% over normal acreage of 304.05 lakh hectares.

According to latest update, area sown until 03 February'17 is 317.81 lakh hectares compared to 297.25 lakh hectares in the previous Rabi season. Among various states the area is down in Jammu & Kashmir and Karnataka, whereas Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh have seen an increase in area compared to last year for the same date. The normal area is 304.05 lakh hectares. Area is expected to be higher this year as government has increased MSP of wheat which has motivated farmers to sow more area.

#### International Market Update:

**GASC has purchased 300000 tonnes of wheat through tender.** Of the total quantity 120000 tonnes is of Russian origin, 120000 tonnes is of Romanian origin and 60000 tonnes is of French origin. Aston offered 60000 tonnes of Russian wheat at FoB \$203.45 per tonne, ADM offered 60000 tonnes of Romanian wheat at FoB \$204.60 per tonne, Ameropa offered 60000 tonnes of Romanian wheat at FoB \$206.08 per tonne, Solaris offered 60000 tonnes of Russian wheat at FoB \$204.60 per tonne, Ameropa offered 60000 tonnes of Russian origin, and Casillo offered 60000 tonnes of French wheat at FoB \$203 per tonne.

Wheat area in Ukraine came to around 6.28 million hectares. Farmers have started harvesting wheat and as of now they have harvested around 5.6 million tonnes of wheat. The ministry has given no official forecast regarding production of wheat harvest but analysts believe it to be around 23-25 million tonnes.

As per latest update by USDA around 34% of spring wheat is in good or excellent condition compared to 69% a year ago. Further around 75% of winter wheat has been harvested compared to 67% a week ago.

As on 14th July Russia has harvested 10.7 million tonnes of wheat compared to 14.2 million tonnes a year ago for the same date. Around 2.3 million hectares of area has been harvested with an average yield of 4.62 tonnes per hectare compared to 3.2 million hectares with an average yield of 4.42 tonnes per hectare a year ago for same date.

As per latest update, Japan's ministry of agriculture bought 93765 MMT of food quality wheat from United States and Australia. Around 62900 MMT with minimum protein content of 14 percent has been bought from United States to be loaded between August 21 - September 20 and 30865 MMT of standard white has been bought from west Australia to be loaded between September 1- September 30.

Outlook: Cash market is expected to trade steady to firm in the near term.
