

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

Import quotes for wheat from different origins to Tuticorin port has decreased compared to last week due to high carryover stocks with major exporting countries. Furthermore good production forecast for upcoming wheat crop of black sea region has also led to fall in quotes. As of now Tuticorin port price for APW is Rs 1860 per quintal, ASW is Rs 1790 per quintal and Ukraine is Rs 1690 per quintal.

FCI will sell a total quantity 1131350 tonnes of wheat in different states through e-auction on 24th August at a reserve price of Rs 1790 per quintal. Of the total quantity in OMSS, highest quantity of 401300 tonnes is offered in Punjab followed by 265000 tonnes in Maharashtra, 146450 tonnes in Haryana, 60000 tonnes in West Bengal, 50000 tonnes in Odhisa, 48950 tonnes in M.P, 25000 tonnes in Tamil Nadu, 22050 tonnes in Karnataka, 20000 tonnes in Rajasthan, 16700 tonnes in Kerala, 16500 tonnes in Gujarat, 16000 tonnes in Delhi, 7000 tonnes in Chandigarh, 6200 tonnes in Uttarakhand, 6200 tonnes in J&K, 5000 tonnes in Uttar Pradesh, 4500 tonnes in Chhattisgarh, 4000 tonnes in Assam, 3000 tonnes in Pondicherry, 2000 tonnes in Bihar, 2000 tonnes in Andhra Pradesh, 1500 tonnes in Himachal Pradesh, 1000 tonnes in Goa and 1000 tonnes in Jharkhand.

All India weekly average prices decreased by 6.46 percent to Rs. 1762.94 per quintal during the week ended 15th August 2017. Wheat average price were ruling at Rs 1884.72 per quintal during 01-08 August 2017. As compared to prices in the week 09-15 August 2016, the prices are weak by 1.49 percent. Prices are expected to remain steady to firm in coming days.

As per fourth advance estimate for 2016-17 wheat production is likely to be around 98.8 MMT which is higher compared to third advance estimate of 97.4 MMT. The total food grain production has been pegged at 275.68 MMT compared to 251.57 MMT in final estimate of 2015-16.

As per latest update, wheat stock in central pool as on 1st August'17 stood at 300.59 lakh tonnes down by 6.87% compared to last month. This quantity is higher by around 11.83% compared to last year for the same month. For the month of July off take from central pool was around 22.16 lakh tonnes compared to 33.02 lakh tonnes for July '2016 and 19.95 lakh tonnes for July'2015. Off take is likely to increase in the coming months due to seasonal demand. FCI is currently selling wheat through E-Auction at a reserve price of Rs. 1790 per quintal.

According to latest update, area sown until 03 February'17 is 317.81 lakh hectares compared to 297.25 lakh hectares in the previous Rabi season. Among various states the area is down in Jammu & Kashmir and Karnataka, whereas Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh have seen an increase in area compared to last year for the same date. The normal area is 304.05 lakh hectares. Area is expected to be higher this year as government has increased MSP of wheat which has motivated farmers to sow more area.

International Market Update:

As per forecast of IKAR, Russia is likely to produce a record 79-82 MMT of wheat in 2017 compared to 77-80 MMT in 2016. The rise in production is mainly due to good yield this year (4.27 tonnes per hectare) compared to last year (3.63 tonnes per hectare).

Saudi Arabia's main state wheat buying agency the Saudi Grains Organization (SAGO) has purchased 490000 tonnes of hard wheat. The quantity will be shipped in 8 consignments with 5 to be shipped at port of Jeddah and rest at port of Dammam. Of the total quantity to be shipped at Jeddah port, 60000 tonnes was bought from ADM at \$214.78 C&F, 60000 tonnes was bought from Holbud limited at \$216.43 C&F, 60000 tonnes was bought from Holbud at \$216.98 C&F, 60000 tonnes was bought from Graincorp at \$214.47 C&F and 60000 tonnes was bought from Holbud at \$218.10 C&F. As per latest update by USDA on 21st August'17 around 34% of spring wheat is in good or excellent condition compared to 66% a year ago. Further around 58% of spring wheat has been harvested compared to 63% a week ago.

As on 17th August Russia has harvested 55.7 million tonnes of wheat compared to 52.2 million tonnes a year ago for the same date. Around 13.0 million hectares of area has been harvested with an average yield of 4.27 tonnes per hectare compared to 14.4 million hectares with an average yield of 3.63 tonnes per hectare a year ago for same date.

GASC has purchased 355000 tonnes of wheat through tender. Of the total quantity 295000 tonnes is of Russian origin and 60000 tonnes is of Ukrainian origin.
