

### Wheat Daily Fundamental Report 18th, September- 2017

#### Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

Wheat WPI has increased from 136.3 in July to 137.1 in August-2017. As compared to August-16, wheat WPI is down by around 2.00 and up by 11.00 compared to August -2015.

As per latest update, wheat stock in central pool as on 1st September'17 stood at 278.16 lakh tonnes down by 7.46% compared to last month. This quantity is higher by around 14.73% compared to last year for the same month. For the month of August off take from central pool was around 22.43 lakh tonnes compared to 26.34 lakh tonnes for August'2016 and 15.02 lakh tonnes for August'2015. FCI is currently selling wheat through E-Auction at a reserve price of Rs. 1790 per quintal.

Import quotes for wheat from different origins to Tuticorin port has increased compared to last week. As of now Tuticorin port price for APW is Rs 1860 per quintal, ASW is Rs 1780 per quintal and Ukrainian wheat at Rs 1670 per quintal. India is likely to import 3-4 million tonnes of wheat in 2017-18. Government may increase import duty from 10% in order to curb imports and provide support to domestic prices. Fall in production forecast for Australia has increased quotes for APW and ASW.

All India weekly average prices decreased by 0.51 percent to Rs. 1799.86 per quintal during the week ended 08th September 2017. Wheat average price were ruling at Rs 1809.16 per quintal during 24-31 August 2017. As compared to prices in the week 01-08 September 2016, the prices are weak by 1.57 percent. Prices are expected to remain steady to weak in coming days.

India is continuously importing wheat from Black sea region and Australia as it is cheaper compared to domestic wheat even after including the current import duty of 10%. As of now Rajkot mill quality is being offered at \$256 per tonne whereas millers in India have contracted to import 8 lakh tonnes from blacksea region at CnF \$200-210 per tonne. Government is considering to increase import duty in order to curb wheat imports and provide support to domestic wheat prices. Sowing of wheat is likely to start in coming months and if prices remain at low level overall acreage may fall in comparison to last year.

India is likely to import 800000 tonnes of wheat in september and october from blacksea region at \$200-210 per tonne cost and freight after taking into account 10% of duty. According to traders there is not much price advantage, millers are buying to ensure smooth supplies in November and December. The only fear importers are facing is an increase in import duty or abrupt change in phytosanitary measures.

As per fourth advance estimate for 2016-17 wheat production is likely to be around 98.8 MMT which is higher compared to third advance estimate of 97.4 MMT. The total food grain production has been pegged at 275.68 MMT compared to 251.57 MMT in final estimate of 2015-16.

According to latest update, area sown until 03 February'17 is 317.81 lakh hectares compared to 297.25 lakh hectares in the previous Rabi season. Among various states the area is down in Jammu & Kashmir and Karnataka, whereas Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh have seen an increase in area compared to last year for the same date. The normal area is 304.05 lakh hectares. Area is expected to be higher this year as government has increased MSP of wheat which has motivated farmers to sow more area.

#### International Market Update:

As on 14th September Russia has harvested 75.70 million tonnes of wheat compared to 70.5 million tonnes a year ago for the same date. Around 21.6 million hectares of area has been harvested with an average yield of 3.51 tonnes per hectare compared to 23.9 million hectares with an average yield of 2.95 tonnes per hectare a year ago for same date. Russia is expected to harvest 80-82 million tonnes of wheat in 2017.

Russian milling wheat prices with 12.5% protein content increased by around \$2-3 per tonne compared to last week. As per traders prices have already touched their lowest level. Furthermore farmers are also holding onto their crops in expectation of better prices. Russia is expected to produce 80-82 MMT of wheat this year compared to 72 MMT last year. As of now Russian milling wheat with 12.5% protein content at Novorossiysk port is being quoted at FoB \$184-187/tonne whereas milling wheat with 11.5% protein content is being quoted at FoB \$172-175/tonne.

As per latest update, Japan's ministry of agriculture bought 139382 MMT of food quality wheat from United States, Canada and Australia. Around 55645 MMT with minimum protein content of 14 percent has been bought from United States to be loaded between October 21 and November 20, 33595 MMT of standard white wheat has been bought from west Australia to be loaded between November 01 and November 30 and 50142 MMT with minimum protein content of 13.5 percent has been bought from United States to be loaded between October 21 and November 20.

Outlook: Cash market is expected to trade steady to firm in the near term.
