

**Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:**

**Traders in wholesale agriculture produce markets in Rajasthan and Gujarat went on strike** demanding commission on purchase of commodities at MSP.

**As per trade sources imported wheat from various origins to Tuticorin port witnessed firm tone in the week. As of now Ukrainian wheat is Rs 2120-2130 per quintal.** Australian Standard Wheat (ASW) and Australian Premium Wheat (APW) is not available in the domestic market. Stock of imported wheat has declined in past months as no quantity has been imported since February 2018 from Australia or Black sea region.

**Government has offered 10636250 tonnes of wheat in OMSS since July until third tender in August** out of which 470950 tonnes was sold. Total numbers of rakes sold were 3. State government and bulk consumers bought 197700 tonnes and 265300 tonnes of wheat respectively. 7950 tonnes was sold in dedicated movement. Government will sell wheat in open market at a reserve price of Rs 1900 per quintal in the second quarter i.e. July-September. For third and fourth quarter prices will be Rs 1925 per quintal and Rs 1950 per quintal respectively.

**All India weekly average prices decreased by 2.82 percent to Rs. 1963.48 per quintal** during the week ended 31st August 2018. Wheat average price were ruling at Rs 2020.39 per quintal during 16-23 August 2018. As compared to prices in the week 24-31 August 2017, the prices are weak by 2.08 percent. Prices are expected to remain firm in coming days due to good domestic demand.

**As per fourth advance estimate, wheat production has been pegged at 99.70 MMT** compared to 98.61 MMT in its third advance estimate issued in the month of May-2018. Total food grain output is expected to be around 284.43 MMT compared to 279.51 MMT in earlier estimate.

**As per trade sources, after increase in import duty to 30 percent imports have decreased substantially.** India has imported no wheat in the month of July-2018. Imports are expected to be low this year due to good domestic availability and increase in import duty. India has imported around 31000 tonnes in the month of February-2018. As of now there is no import parity.

**As per trade source, India has exported around 0.72 thousand tonnes in the month of July compared to 2.17 thousand tonnes in June.** The quantity in July was exported at an average FOB of \$ 565.92 per tonne and the major destinations were Somalia, Sri Lanka, Nepal, UAE, Malaysia, Kuwait and Saudi Arabia. Exports are likely to be at lower side as other countries are able to provide quality wheat at competitive prices.

**Previous Updates:**

**As per latest update, wheat stock in central pool as on 1st August'18 stood at 405.58 lakh tonnes down by 2.97% compared to last month.** This quantity is higher by around 34.93% compared to last year for the same month. Government has already applied import duty on wheat to curb imports and provide support to domestic prices. The stock position as on 01st August'18 is highest in last four years. Therefore, government has abundant supplies this year to tackle any unexpected rise in wheat prices by selling more quantity in open market.

**International Market Update:**

**Russian milling wheat prices became weak by \$4-5 per tonne at Novorossiysk and \$4-5 per tonne at Odessa compared to last week.** Weak demand in international market kept prices at lower side. As per USDA, Russia is expected to produce 68.00 MMT in 2018 compared to 84.99 MMT in 2017. As of now Russian milling wheat with 12.5% protein content at Novorossiysk port is being quoted at FoB \$220.00-226.00/tonne whereas milling wheat whereas wheat with 12.5% protein content at Odessa is being quoted at FoB \$220.00-226.00/tonne.

**Egypt has purchased 350000 tonnes of Russian and Ukrainian wheat through tender.** Of the total quantity 60000 tonnes was Ukrainian wheat and remaining was Russian wheat. Louis Dreyfus offered 60000 tonnes of Ukrainian wheat at FOB \$223.50/tonne, Glencore offered two cargoes (Russian wheat) each of 55000 tonnes at an FOB of \$221.51/tonne and \$223.51/tonne, Garant offered 60000 tonnes of Russian wheat at FOB \$225.90/tonne, GTSC offered two cargoes (Russian wheat) each of 60000 tonnes at an FOB of \$225.50/tonne. The said quantities are to be delivered during 11-20 October-2018. In its previous tender on 14th August 2018, Egypt has bought 420000 tonnes of wheat from Russia and Romania.

**As on 21st August, Russia has harvested around 54.2 MMT of wheat** from 16 million hectares of land compared to 59.5 MMT last year for the same date. Harvesting in Ukraine is complete and Ukraine has harvested 25 MMT of wheat compared to 26.6 MMT last year. In July-18, Russia and Ukraine has exported 3.9 MMT has exported 0.43 MMT of wheat respectively. Prices are ruling at higher side in Black Sea due to lower production and good export demand.

**Outlook:** Cash market is expected to trade steady to firm in the near term.
