

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

All India weekly average prices increased by 0.84 percent to Rs. 2034.69 per quintal during the week ended 15th October 2018. Wheat average price were ruling at Rs 2017.72 per quintal during 01-08 October 2018. As compared to prices in the week 09-15 October 2017, the prices are firm by 6.13 percent. Prices are expected to remain firm in coming days due to good domestic demand.

As per trade sources imported wheat from various origins to Tuticorin port witnessed firm tone in the week. As of now Ukrainian wheat is being quoted at Rs 2195-2202 per quintal. Australian Standard Wheat (ASW) and Australian Premium Wheat (APW) are not available in domestic market. Stock of imported wheat is very low as no quantity has been imported since February 2018 from Australia or Black sea region.

India mainly imports from Australia and Russia. Wheat prices have become firm in both the countries due to lower production. As of now, Russian wheat with 12.5 percent protein content and Australian premium wheat (APW) is being quoted at \$340 (Rs 25040) per tonne and \$367 (Rs 27000) per tonne respectively, after including freight and import duty @30%. Whereas wheat mill quality price in South India is ruling around Rs 23500-24000 per tonne.

As per latest update, wheat stock in central pool as on 1st October'18 stood at 356.25 lakh tonnes down by 7.49% compared to last month. This quantity is higher by around 37.73% compared to last year for the same month. Government has already applied import duty on wheat to curb imports and provide support to domestic prices The stock position as on 01st October'18 is highest in last four years. Therefore, government has abundant supplies this year to tackle any unexpected rise in wheat prices by selling more quantity in open market.

As per latest update, hybrid varieties of wheat such as HD 8579, HD 4728, HW 5207, HS 562, HD 3171 and HD 1605 have been introduced for upcoming Rabi season. All the hybrid varieties have good yields especially when used in irrigated areas. In case farmers go for these varieties in upcoming Rabi season, production is expected to increase.

As per trade sources, after increase in import duty to 30 percent imports have decreased substantially. India has imported no wheat in the month of August-2018. Imports are expected to be low this year due to good domestic availability and increase in import duty. India has imported around 31000 tonnes in the month of February-2018. As of now there is no import parity.

As per trade source, India has exported around 1.90 thousand tonnes in the month of August compared to 0.72 thousand tonnes in July. The quantity in July was exported at an average FOB of \$ 420.97 per tonne and the major destinations were South Africa, Sri Lanka, UAE, Malaysia, Congo and Bahrain. Exports are likely to be at lower side as other countries are able to provide quality wheat at competitive prices.

Previous Updates:

As per fourth advance estimate, wheat production has been pegged at 99.70 MMT compared to 98.61 MMT in its third advance estimate issued in the month of May-2018. Total food grain output is expected to be around 284.43 MMT compared to 279.51 MMT in earlier estimate.

International Market Update:

As on 05th October Russia has harvested 70.2 million tonnes of wheat compared to 85.5 million tonnes a year ago for the same date. Around 24.7 million hectares of area has been harvested with an average yield of 2.84 tonnes per hectare compared to 26.2 million hectares with an average yield of 3.26 tonnes per hectare a year ago for same date. Russia has harvested record crop last year.

As per the Rosario grain exchange, Argentina is likely to harvest 19 MMT compared to 21 MMT in its previous estimate. The forecast has been revised down due to dry weather during September and first ten days of October.

Ukrainian wheat exports have touched 5.8 MMT until September-18, which represents 36 percent of the amount projected in the Memorandum signed by grain market participants and the Agrarian Policy Ministry. Of the total quantity exported 2.5 MMT is fodder wheat and 3.3 MMT is milling wheat. As per the memorandum signed on 10th August for MY 2018-19, export of milling and fodder wheat is expected at 8 MMT each.

Russian milling wheat prices became firm by \$3 per tonne at Novorossiysk and \$3 per tonne at Odessa compared to last week. Wheat prices remained firm due to strong ruble and concerns over export related matters such as tightening phytosanitary rules and longer time to get necessary certificates. As per USDA, Russia is expected to produce 68.50 MMT in 2018 compared to 84.99 MMT in 2017. As of now Russian milling wheat with 12.5% protein content at Novorossiysk port is being quoted at FoB \$223.00-229.00/tonne whereas milling wheat whereas wheat with 12.5% protein content at Odessa is being quoted at FoB \$223.00-229.00/tonne.

Outlook: Cash market is expected to trade steady to firm in the near term.
