

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

FCI will offer a total quantity 2598950 tonnes of wheat in different states through e-auction on 25th October 2018 at a reserve price of Rs 1925 per quintal.

As per trade sources, after increase in import duty to 30 percent imports have decreased substantially. India has imported 1000 tonnes of milling wheat from Pakistan at \$ 318.53 per tonne (Including import duty) in the month of September-2018. Imports are expected to be low this year due to good domestic availability and increase in import duty. India has imported around 31000 tonnes in the month of February-2018.

As per trade source, India has exported around 2.80 thousand tonnes in the month of September compared to 1.90 thousand tonnes in August. The quantity in September was exported at an average FOB of \$ 381.68 per tonne and the major destinations were Nepal, UAE, Sri Lanka and New Zealand. Exports are likely to be at lower side as other countries are able to provide quality wheat at competitive prices.

Wheat WPI has increased from 148.6 in August -2018 to 149.8 in September-2018. Monthly wheat inflation has increased by 0.81 percent in September -2018 compared to previous month. As compared to September-2017 wheat WPI has increased by around 8.87 percent. Wheat WPI is expected to stay steady to slightly firm in coming months.

All India weekly average prices increased by 0.84 percent to Rs. 2034.69 per quintal during the week ended 15th October 2018. Wheat average price were ruling at Rs 2017.72 per quintal during 01-08 October 2018. As compared to prices in the week 09-15 October 2017, the prices are firm by 6.13 percent. Prices are expected to remain firm in coming days due to good domestic demand.

As per trade sources imported wheat from various origins to Tuticorin port witnessed firm tone in the week. As of now Ukrainian wheat is being quoted at Rs 2195-2202 per quintal. Australian Standard Wheat (ASW) and Australian Premium Wheat (APW) are not available in domestic market. Stock of imported wheat is very low as no quantity has been imported since February 2018 from Australia or Black sea region.

India mainly imports from Australia and Russia. Wheat prices have become firm in both the countries due to lower production. As of now, Russian wheat with 12.5 percent protein content and Australian premium wheat (APW) is being quoted at \$340 (Rs 25040) per tonne and \$367 (Rs 27000) per tonne respectively, after including freight and import duty @30%. Whereas wheat mill quality price in South India is ruling around Rs 23500-24000 per tonne.

As per latest update, hybrid varieties of wheat such as HD 8579, HD 4728, HW 5207, HS 562, HD 3171 and HD 1605 have been introduced for upcoming Rabi season. All the hybrid varieties have good yields especially when used in irrigated areas. In case farmers go for these varieties in upcoming Rabi season, production is expected to increase.

Previous Updates:

As per fourth advance estimate, wheat production has been pegged at 99.70 MMT compared to 98.61 MMT in its third advance estimate issued in the month of May-2018. Total food grain output is expected to be around 284.43 MMT compared to 279.51 MMT in earlier estimate.

International Market Update:

Russian milling wheat prices became firm by \$2-3 per tonne at Novorossiysk and \$0-1 per tonne at Odessa compared to last week. Wheat prices remained firm due to strong ruble and difficulty in receiving phytosanitary certificates. As per USDA, Russia is expected to produce 70.00 MMT in 2018 compared to 84.99 MMT in 2017. As of now Russian milling wheat with 12.5% protein content at Novorossiysk port is being quoted at FoB \$230.00-235.00/tonne and milling wheat with 12.5% protein content at Odessa is being quoted at FoB \$226.00-232.00/tonne.

Morocco will suspend import duty on wheat during from 01st November-31st December'18 and a duty of 30 percent will be applicable from 01st January'19. This step has been taken to increase supply and avoid price hikes in domestic market.

Ukraine has sown 6.43 million hectares of grain against expected area of 7.2 million hectares for harvest in 2019. Of the total sown area, 5.6 million hectares is winter wheat. Ukraine wheat production fell to 25.5 MMT in 2018-19 compared to 27.0 MMT in 2017-18.

Jordan has bought 60000 tonnes of hard milling wheat at \$257 per tonne cost and freight for delivery in second half of December. The tender closed on Wednesday and wheat can be sourced from optional origin. The seller was trading house CHS. One other companies, Ameropa offered wheat at \$266.70 per tonne.

Outlook: Cash market is expected to trade steady to weak in the near term.
