

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

Mostly steady to firm trend featured in Wheat spot markets followed by rising exports demand. Arrivals are comparatively slow in the market as traders are waiting for better prices than prevailing price of the market. In India, traders are maintaining enough stocks to fulfill needs of buyers.

All India weekly average prices declined by 0.039 percent to Rs. 2093.74 per quintal during the week ended 1-6 December 2018. Wheat average price were ruling at Rs 2094.57 per quintal during 23-29 November 2018. As compared to prices in the week 1-6 December 2017, the current week prices are firm by 16.80 percent. Prices are expected to remain firm in coming days due to good domestic demand and low imports.

According to latest update, area sown until 30th November'18 is 152.97 lakh hectares compared to 156.76 lakh hectares in the previous Rabi season. It is down by 15.12% against previous week record and 2.42% down from last year record during the same period of time. The normal area is 306.26 lakh hectares. Acreage is expected to be higher this Rabi season due to increase in MSP by Rs 105 per quintal for MY 2018-19.

As per Reuters, India may produce lower size of Wheat in 2019 followed by lower moisture levels and higher temperatures in key growing regions like Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, and the Western state of Gujarat. Due to lower moisture level, the water supplies in the fields is the main cause therefore farmers are not able to get the efficient water through the tube wells also. As a result, prices may rise in the future which may relax to angry farmers in India. Two main state of India for growing Wheat i.e. Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh got a tenth less rainfall than normal during the June - September monsoon season in 2018. As on November 30, 2018, Indian Farmers have plated wheat near 15.3 hectares which is lower against 15.7 million hectares in the previous year during the same period of time.

As per trade source, India has exported around 5.09 thousand tonnes in the month of October compared to 2.80 thousand tonnes in September. The quantity in October was exported at an average FOB of \$ 315.91 per tonne and the major destinations were Nepal, UAE and Bahrain. Exports are likely to be at lower side as other countries are able to provide quality wheat at competitive prices.

As per latest update, wheat stock in central pool as on 1st November'18 stood at 331.35 lakh tonnes down by 6.99% compared to last month. This quantity is higher by around 38.93% compared to last year for the same month. Government has already applied import duty on wheat to curb imports and provide support to domestic prices The stock position as on 01st November'18 is highest in last four years. Therefore, government has abundant supplies this year to tackle any unexpected rise in wheat prices by selling more quantity in open market.

Previous Updates:

As per fourth advance estimate, wheat production has been pegged at 99.70 MMT compared to 98.61 MMT in its third advance estimate issued in the month of May-2018. Total food grain output is expected to be around 284.43 MMT compared to 279.51 MMT in earlier estimate.

International Market Update:

As per latest update, Japan's ministry of agriculture bought 143,643 MT of food quality wheat from United States and Canada. Around 62975 MT has been bought from United States and 59,378 MT of western red spring has been bought from Canada. Shipments from United States and Canada will be loaded between Dec 21-2018 and Jan 20-2019.

As per sources, The Taiwan Flour Millers' Association purchased 110,000 tonnes of milling wheat from the United States in a tender on 5th Dec 2018. The first consignment was issued between Jan. 22 and Feb. 5 including 29,795 tonnes of U.S. dark northern spring wheat of 14.5 percent protein content bought at \$259.26 a tonne FOB U.S. Pacific Northwest coast.

As per sources, Russia shipped total Wheat higher by 19.3% to 20.4 million Tonnes during the period started from 1st July 2018 to 29 November 2018 in agricultural year (2018/19) against leap year on year. Exports volume increased by 10% if compare to same period of time in 2017-18 agriculture year. The Agriculture Ministry says, Russia may export total 35 million T of Wheat in this year. While, the country had sold over 40.4 million T of wheat in previous year.

Outlook: Cash market is expected to trade steady to firm in the near term.
