

**Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:**

**As per latest update, area sown until 11th January'18 is 294.07 lakh hectares compared to 300.51 lakh hectares in the previous Rabi season.** The normal area is 306.29 lakh hectares. Acreage is expected to be higher this Rabi season due to increase in MSP by Rs 105 per quintal for MY 2018-19. Acreage of wheat in Madhya Pradesh is higher as farmers have shifted from chickpea. This year, as on 11th January'18, farmers have sowed 59.00 lakh hectares of wheat in Madhya Pradesh compared to 58.03 Lakh hectares last year on same date.

**Wheat WPI has increased from 152.2 in November-2018 to 152.8 in December-2018.** Monthly wheat inflation has increased by 0.39 percent in December-2018 compared to previous month. As compared to December-2017 wheat WPI has increased by around 9.61 percent. Wheat WPI is expected to stay steady to weak in coming months.

**As per latest update, Conducive weather conditions have increased the probability of good harvest in MY 2019-20.** Low temperatures during day and night, with clear skies have boosted vegetative growth of the crop. Furthermore, low temperature has also helped in retaining soil moisture, which otherwise would have adversely impacted the crop in absence of rain. Good production in MY 2019-20 may lead to oversupply in domestic market.

**Haryana is one of the key wheat producing state in India.** Production is likely to be higher as farmers have sown high yielding varieties such as HD-2967, HD-3086, WH-1105, etc. Low temperature in Haryana will further support yield. There are no reports of yellow rust in North India so far.

**All India weekly average prices increased by 4.12 percent to Rs. 2167.57 per quintal during the week ended 08th January 2019.** Wheat average price were ruling at Rs 2081.86 per quintal during 24-31 December 2018. As compared to prices in the week 01-08 January 2018, the prices are firm by 11.61 percent. Prices are expected to remain firm in coming days due to good domestic demand and low imports.

**As per trade sources, after increase in import duty to 30 percent imports** have decreased substantially. India has imported no wheat in the month of November-2018. Imports are expected to be low this year due to good domestic availability and increase in import duty. India has imported around 1000 tonnes in the month of September-2018.

**As per trade source, India has exported around 2.73 thousand tonnes in the month of November compared to 5.09 thousand tonnes in October.** The quantity in November was exported at an average FOB of \$ 416.11 per tonne and the major destinations were Nepal, Sri Lanka and Somalia. Exports are likely to be at lower side as other countries are able to provide quality wheat at competitive prices.

**Previous Updates:**

**As per fourth advance estimate, wheat production has been pegged at 99.70 MMT compared to 98.61 MMT in its third advance estimate** issued in the month of May-2018. Total food grain output is expected to be around 284.43 MMT compared to 279.51 MMT in earlier estimate.

**International Market Update:**

**Russian milling wheat prices remained steady in past week as low trading activity was observed for wheat due to holidays.** As per IGC, Russia is expected to produce 69.50 MMT in 2018 compared to 84.90 MMT in 2017. As of now Russian milling wheat with 12.5% protein content at Novorossiysk port is being quoted at FoB \$235.00-240.00/tonne and milling wheat with 12.5% protein content at Odessa is being quoted at FoB \$234.00-240.00/tonne.

**Indonesia has bought 30000 MT of wheat from Argentina at \$270 per tonne.** Asian flour millers are expected to seek rare wheat shipments from Argentina in coming months as a second year of drought in traditional supplier Australia has curbed supplies.

**Drought in Australia has led Agrocrops to import 33000 MT of wheat from west Australia to east Australia.** West Australia wheat is generally exported to Asia and Middle-East. Therefore, west Australia wheat is being imported by east to meet the local demand.

**Bangladesh has witnessed a tremendous growth in imports in past five years, due to change in consumption pattern of population.** Imports have increased from 1.8 MMT in FY 2012-13 to 5.4 MMT in FY 2016-17. Bangladesh is likely to import wheat from black sea region in near future.

**Russia has imposed a ban on import of more than fifty products, including wheat, from Ukraine.** This is a tit-for-tat measure by the Russian government as Ukraine has banned import of more than 30 products in December-18.

**Outlook:** Cash market is likely to trade steady to weak in the near term on improved demand.
