

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

According to Punjab state Govt., Punjab had procured 115 lakh metric tonne of wheat in a record days in less than a month, of which over 90 LMT has been lifted. An additional 20 lakh metric tonne of wheat is expected to be procured in the coming days.

Mild to moderate showers were witnessed in parts of the Punjab on Sunday morning, raising apprehension of delay in the lifting of wheat crop from grain markets. Moderate showers were witnessed in Gurdaspur, Hoshiarpur, Nawanshahr and Ropar districts, and mild showers in Ludhiana and Jalandhar. In these districts, wheat has already been harvested. This can delay the lifting of the produce. As of now, 80 per cent of the wheat in mandis has already been lifted. Along with this, the worry of the arduous has also increased due to the reduction of Luster Loss.

Procurement of wheat in the rabi season has so far been less by 18.35 per cent this year due to the Covid-19 crisis. However, there was no shortage of food grain and procurement was on track. "As on date cumulative procurement of wheat in the rabi marketing season 2020-21 is 226.85 LMT whereas it was 277.83 LMT during the corresponding period in 2019-20,"

In over 22 days of staggered wheat procurement, Punjab has procured 78% of the targeted produce so far, crossing the 100 lakh metric tonne (LMT) mark. Of the estimated 135 LMT of wheat, grain markets have recorded arrival of 105.14 LMT so far, of which 104 LMT had been procured. Wheat arrival, which hovered around 6 LMT last week, fell to 4.14 LMT on Wednesday as farmers were in a hurry to sell due to uncertainty over issuance of e-passes.

The Food Corporation of India (FCI) has been able to buy half of its wheat procurement target of 40.7 million tonne by Wednesday despite a delayed start this year as Punjab has exceeded expectation by purchasing nearly 75% of its target in only 22 days.

According to FCI the latest procurement data by FCI and state agencies as on 6th of may Punjab 100.16 LMT followed by Haryana 47.65 LMT, Uttar Pradesh 8.73 LMT, Madhya Pradesh 44.46 LMT and Rajasthan 2.36 LMT.

In Madhya Pradesh a record procurement of more than five lakh metric tonnes was made in a single day. So far, a total of 45 lakh metric tonnes of wheat have been purchased from eight lakh farmers in the state. The purchase made in 40 days last year, has been made in 20 days this year. An amount of Rs 4,175 crore has been paid to 4 lakh 90 thousand farmers.

According to Punjab state Govt, Punjab had procured 100 lakh metric tonne of wheat in a record 20 days on Wednesday. An additional 35 lakh metric tonne of wheat is expected to be procured in the coming days.

According to state Govt, 45 percent of wheat procurement target had been achieved in Punjab, rains had affected the wheat crop in central Punjab, adding that strict action was being taken over wheat hoarding and smuggling and flour mills had also been given permission to keep stock for 72 hours.

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According to FCI the state wise procurement of wheat till 01.05.2020 was Punjab 74.16 LMT, Haryana 33.74, U.P 5.92 LMT and M.P 27.60 LMT and Rajasthan 1.40 LMT respectively.

According to Punjab state Govt "over 2.22 lakh metric tonnes (MT) of wheat has arrived at grain markets in the district so far". Almost 32% of the crop has arrived at the markets and harvesting will be completed with next 10 days. Government agencies have procured around 2.14 lakh MT of wheat till date.

Wheat is being procured through 167 purchasing centers in the Behaich district. According to District Food Marketing Officer, 12 thousand MT of wheat has been purchased in the district. However, many purchasing centers had problems in purchase due to lack of sacks. This was due to the closure of jute mills during lock down. On which sacks have been collected from the Kotdars.

International Market Update:

According to USDA Canada's wheat production in 2020-21 is expected to increase slightly on a 2% increase in area planted and a decrease in area abandoned. Wheat production is estimated at 33.8 million tonnes, up from an estimated production of 32.3 million tonnes in 2019-20. Marketing year 2019-20 was marked with unfavourable weather conditions, transportation challenges, market access issues and then the coronavirus (COVID-19).

European Union wheat exporters are set to record their best export season for years with record shipments expected from top exporter France, traders said on Wednesday. For the current July 2019/June 2020 season, the EU Commission this week raised its monthly forecast for exports of soft wheat, or common wheat, from the EU plus Britain to 31.8 million tonnes, a four-year high.

Ukrainian farmers since the beginning of 2019-2020 Marketing Year, exported 19.08 million tonnes of wheat, which is 95% of the export ceiling of 20 million tonnes approved by the Ministry for Development of Economy, Trade, and Agriculture.
