

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

Haryana government on Friday allowed procurement of wheat from other states through "Meri Fasal-Mera Beyora" portal, a decision taken after pressure from Arthiyas (procurement agents). The farmers from other states will be able to register on the portal from May 17. Haryana government has set a target of 10 lakh MT wheat purchase from other states and would not buy more than 360 quintal wheat from a single farmer.

Accoding to Punjab state Govt. 92% of expected arrival of 135 lakh tonnes of wheat had been procured in Punjab. 122.02 lakh tonnes had arrived in mandis in which, 121.85 lakh tonnes had been purchased in a month despite staggered movement of wheat amid the coronavirus pandemic. More than 95 per cent wheat had been procured in 15 of the 22 Punjab districts

Despite the clouser of all 247 Agriculture produce marketing committee due too ongoing strike in rajasthan, the state continues to purchase wheat. The FCI has procured 1,42,044 metric tonnes of wheat were procured by state govt agencies, while 5,66,466 metric tonnes were procured by FCI.

In Punjab nearly 33 per cent of the total wheat crop procured by different state and Central government procurement agencies has not been lifted from different grain markets of the district. The slow lifting process resulted in trouble for arhtiyas and labourers at grain markets as the area received substantial rain in the morning on Thursday.

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According to State Government, despite a delayed start to wheat procurement, Madhya Pradesh has so far procured over 66 lakh tonnes 63.67 lakh tonnes till Monday as against 53 LT in the corresponding period last year and is well on the path to achieve the upwardly revised procurement target of 95 LT.

The sealing of border due to Covid has curbed the arrival of wheat from UP to the tune of 21 lakh quintal in Palwal. This has led to a 37.5 per cent dip in the overall procurement here this season.

According to Punjab state Govt., Punjab had procured 115 lakhs metric tonne of wheat in a record day in less than a month, of which over 90 LMT has been lifted. An additional 20 lakhs metric tonne of wheat is expected to be procured in the coming days.

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Mild to moderate showers were witnessed in parts of the Punjab on Sunday morning, raising apprehension of delay in the lifting of wheat crop from grain markets. Moderate showers were witnessed in Gurdaspur, Hoshiarpur, Nawanshahr and Ropar districts, and mild showers in Ludhiana and Jalandhar. In these districts, wheat has already been harvested. This can delay the lifting of the produce. As of now, 80 per cent of the wheat in mandis has already been lifted. Along with this, the worry of the ardours has also increased due to the reduction of Luster Loss.

Procurement of wheat in the rabi season has so far been less by 18.35 per cent this year due to the Covid-19 crisis. However, there was no shortage of food grain and procurement was on track. "As on date cumulative procurement of wheat in the rabi marketing season 2020-21 is 226.85 LMT whereas it was 277.83 LMT during the corresponding period in 2019-20,"

In over 22 days of staggered wheat procurement, Punjab has procured 78% of the targeted produce so far, crossing the 100 lakh metric tonne (LMT) mark. Of the estimated 135 LMT of wheat, grain markets have recorded arrival of 105.14 LMT so far, of which 104 LMT had been procured. Wheat arrival, which hovered around 6 LMT last week, fell to 4.14 LMT on Wednesday as farmers were in a hurry to sell due to uncertainty over issuance of e-passes.

International Market Update:

U.S. wheat futures fell for a second consecutive session on Monday as ample global stocks and sluggish demand caused by the coronavirus pandemic pushed prices to their lowest in nearly a month. The most-active wheat futures on the Chicago Board Of Trade fell 0.2% to \$4.99-1/2 a bushel by 0154 GMT, having closed 0.4% lower on Friday.

Ukraine's wheat sales have reached 19.7 million tonnes as of May 15, leaving only 500,000 tonnes available for export over the rest of the season which runs until June 30, in line with a memorandum signed with traders, economy ministry data showed on Friday.

Ukrainian seaport wheat exports rose nearly 23% in the first week of May to 351,000 tonnes from 286,000 tonnes a week earlier, preliminary data from the APK-Inform consultancy showed on Tuesday. The data showed that Ukraine has already exported 19.460 million tonnes of wheat in the current season, which runs from July to June.
