



Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

According to FCI, only 17.71 lakh tonnes of wheat has been procured at the support price in the current rabi from Uttar Pradesh, the largest wheat producing state, which is only 32.2% of the target 55 lakh tonnes. In the last Rabi, 37 lakh tonnes of wheat was purchased in the state, whereas last year also the target of procurement was fixed at 55 lakh tonnes. The current Rabi is estimated to produce 363 lakh tonnes of wheat in the state and the procurement of wheat started in the state.

According to Haryana Govt. the state government has procured over 71 lakh metric tonne (MT) of wheat. It's being procured at an MSP of ₹1,925 per quintal.

The wheat procurement in Champawat district will run till 31 May. These purchasing centers will be closed on June 1. So far, 1639 quintals and 50 kg have been procured in various centers of the district. Due to the ongoing lockdown under the Corona epidemic, this time wheat procurement started from April 15 instead of April 1.

According to the Govt. this season Indian wheat harvest has been severely interrupted by the national COVID-19 lockdown. As the harvest winds down across most states, the Govt. has increased its production forecast by almost one million tonnes to a record 107.2 million tonnes for the 2019-20 marketing year.

Haryana government on Friday allowed procurement of wheat from other states through "Meri Fasal-Mera Beyora" portal, a decision taken after pressure from Arthiyas (procurement agents). The farmers from other states will be able to register on the portal from May 17. Haryana government has set a target of 10 lakh MT wheat purchase from other states and would not buy more than 360 quintal wheat from a single farmer.

Accoding to Punjab state Govt. 92% of expected arrival of 135 lakh tonnes of wheat had been procured in Punjab. 122.02 lakh tonnes had arrived in mandis in which, 121.85 lakh tonnes had been purchased in a month despite staggered movement of wheat amid the coronavirus pandemic. More than 95 per cent wheat had been procured in 15 of the 22 Punjab districts

Despite the clouser of all 247 Agriculture produce marketing committee due too ongoing strike in rajasthan, the state continues to purchase wheat. The FCI has procured 1,42,044 metric tonnes of wheat were procured by state govt agencies, while 5,66,466 metric tonnes were procured by FCI.

In Punjab nearly 33 per cent of the total wheat crop procured by different state and Central government procurement agencies has not been lifted from different grain markets of the district. The slow lifting process resulted in trouble for arthiyas and labourers at grain markets as the area received substantial rain in the morning on Thursday.

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According to State Government, despite a delayed start to wheat procurement, Madhya Pradesh has so far procured over 66 lakh tonnes 63.67 lakh tonnes till Monday as against 53 LT in the corresponding period last year and is well on the path to achieve the upwardly revised procurement target of 95 LT.

The sealing of border due to Covid has curbed the arrival of wheat from UP to the tune of 21 lakh quintal in Palwal. This has led to a 37.5 per cent dip in the overall procurement here this season.

According to Punjab state Govt., Punjab had procured 115 lakhs metric tonne of wheat in a record day in less than a month, of which over 90 LMT has been lifted. An additional 20 lakhs metric tonne of wheat is expected to be procured in the coming days.

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International Market Update:

CBOT July wheat may fall to \$4.91-3/4 per bushel, as it could have completed a bounce from the May 18 low of \$4.93-3/4. The weak bounce failed to extend above a resistance at \$5.02-1/4, the 150pc projection level on a downtrend from \$5.61-1/2. The trend may have resumed. A break above \$5.02-1/4 could lead to a gain to \$5.06-3/4.

A United Nations aid agency has purchased about 80,000 tonnes of wheat expected to be sourced from Ukraine to be shipped to Sudan, European traders said on Monday. About 40,000 tonnes is to be shipped by the end of May and 40,000 tonnes by the first half of July. The UN has a range of food aid programmes in Sudan.

U.S. wheat futures fell for a second consecutive session on Monday as ample global stocks and sluggish demand caused by the coronavirus pandemic pushed prices to their lowest in nearly a month. The most-active wheat futures on the Chicago Board
