

**Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:**

**According to senior government official, the farm ministry will send a Budget proposal for its flagship National Mission on Edible Oils of 50 bln rupees a year to the finance ministry, If the proposal got approved, then it will be used to promote oilseed cultivation and incentivize farmers to shift to oilseed crops from other remunerative crops; under the mission, the government aims to provide subsidy on good quality seeds and fertilizers to farmers and also soft loans to the processing industry. It will focus on growing more oilseeds like mustard, groundnut in Punjab, Haryana, and Uttar Pradesh, the leading wheat growers. The focus will also be on setting up around 150 oilseed hubs to produce high-yielding, drought-tolerant, and short duration seed varieties. Which is surely going to affect the area of wheat in future.**

**According to traders, Prices of Wheat rose in Indore today** as demand from bulk buyers firmed up amid a largely unchanged food grain supply, traders said. Arrivals were pegged at 5,000 bags (1 bag = 100 kg). However, in Jaipur, wheat prices weakened as bulk demand declined further while arrivals were steady, traders said. Arrivals were largely unchanged at 1,500 bags. However, the outlook is bullish as retail demand is likely to pick up with the government's scheme to provide free food grain to public distribution system beneficiaries having ended in November.

**In this rabi season, the area under wheat sowing has decreased in Jhansi (U.P), while pulses and oilseeds have increased.** It is believed that the attitude of farmers has changed due to lack of water. Pulses and oilseeds consume less water than wheat.

**With the farmers protesting at the Delhi/NCR borders against the three new farm laws, wheat cultivation back home in their States of Punjab, Haryana, and Rajasthan has taken a hit in the current rabi season.** States like Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra, from where not many farmers have participated in the protests, have sown more wheat or rabi crops this year.

**As per latest update, area sown to wheat, has increased marginally by 2.53% to 254.73 lakh hectares** so far in the ongoing 2020-21 rabi season from 248.44 lakh hectares in the year-ago period. The overall trend of rabi sowing progress is excellent with Increased area coverage has been recorded.

**Indian traders have signed two deals to export around 200,000 tonnes of wheat to Bangladesh.** According to market sources, The traders are exporting wheat at \$210-\$220 per tonnes, FOB, and \$250-\$260 per tonnes, free on board, under the two deals in the coming few weeks. The export price of Indian wheat has been falling as domestic prices have weakened over the past few months.

**Over 46 lakh hectares of wheat sowing have been complete in Madhya Pradesh** after favorable conditions for the state's rabi crops. This year, the target for sowing rabi crops has been increasing by about 2 lakh hectares. The agriculture minister said sowing of wheat was completed in 46.74 lakh hectares area till November 23, almost 10 lakh hectare more than last year when the farmers could complete wheat sowing only in 37.27 lakh hectares of land.

**As per trade source, India has Import around 6380 MT in the month of October-2020** after March-2020. The quantity in October-2020 was imported at an average FOB of \$ 304.90 per tonnes.

**International Market Update:**

**US wheat futures edged higher on Tuesday, as prices rebounded from a 3% decline** marked in the previous session, amid expectations of stronger demand for US supplies after leading exporter Russia moved to limit exports.

**World wheat prices remained firm this month, mostly due to dry weather impacting the start of the growing season in the Northern Hemisphere and unfavorable production conditions in Argentina.** Strong global export demand drove further price spikes in Canada, European Union, Russia, and the United States, demonstrated by robust export sales reports this month. Concerns about the rise in COVID-19 infections worldwide and recent rains in Russia and the U.S. Plains softened price increases more recently.

**Australian numbers updates from local analysts** wheat crop expectations rise to 35 MMT. Australia in October 2020 exported only 367.6 thousand MT of Wheat, which is 17% less than in September and the worst October export since 2007.

**Ukraine has exported 21.08 million tonnes of grain so far in the season,** which runs from July 2020 to June 2021, the economy ministry said on Friday. That is 11.3% lower than exports for the same period of the previous season because of lower corn and wheat sales amid a weaker harvest. Exports of wheat have declined to 11.83 million tonnes from 13.15 million tonnes.
