

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

As per the latest update on 07 January 2021, the area under wheat has increased marginally by 2.59% to 335.46 lakh hectares so far in the ongoing 2020-21 Rabi season from 326.75 lakh hectares in the year-ago same period. The overall trend of Rabi sowing progress is excellent, with increased area coverage recorded due to favourable weather. Lesser area reported in states like Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Karnataka.

Prices of wheat continued to rise in the mandis of major producing states except for Delhi on Friday. On Lawrence Road, Delhi, mill quality wheat's price decreased by Rs 15 per quintal from 1965 to Rs 1950 per quintal, while the daily arrival was 2000 bags. There is no rain in the states of North India today, but the weather is still bad. In Hyderabad, the wheat price of Rajasthan line has been increased from Rs 2140 to Rs 2150, UP line to Rs 2100 to Rs 2060 per quintal of Punjab line, and has increased by Rs 10 to 50 per quintal. The price of mill quality wheat in Bangalore today remained steady at Rs 2155 to Rs 2255 per quintal, while in Visakhapatnam, it was Rs 2150 per quintal.

As per market sources, wheat stock in the central pool as of 1st December'20 stood at 367.54 lakh tonnes down by 8.79% compared to last month. This quantity is higher by around 4.56% compared to last year for the same month. The government has abundant supplies this year to tackle any unexpected rise in wheat prices by selling more quantity in the open market and through high exports.

Indian traders are expected to export around 40,000 tonnes of wheat to Bangladesh at \$210-\$220 per tonnes FOB, market sources said. The exports may take place in a few days. More exports to Bangladesh are likely this financial year as prices of wheat in India have become more competitive in the past few months. Last month, Indian traders signed deals with their counterparts in Bangladesh to export around 200,000 tonnes of wheat. High export from India will give support to domestic price.

As per trade sources, India has exported around 1.85 lakh tonnes in the month of November-2020 at an average FOB of \$468.24 per tonnes, higher this year and the major destinations were Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Nepal and UAE. Exports are likely to be at higher side as other countries are providing wheat at higher prices. High export will going to support the domestic market in near term.

International Market Update:

SovEcon has further slashed its 2020-21 Russian wheat export forecast, which could mean rising prices. The Russian agriculture consultancy firm is now predicting 36.3 million tonnes of exports, down from its November forecast of 40.8 million tonnes. That is well below the U.S. Department of Agriculture's December estimate of 40 million tonnes. SovEcon's drastic reduction is in response to Russia's announcement that it is imposing an export tax of 25 euros (US\$30.63) per tonne on Russian wheat between February 15 and June 30. SovEcon initially thought the tax would slice exports by two to three million tonnes.

The weather is currently unfavourable in the global market. Planting in Australia has also decreased, and the weather is not supporting either. Lockdown is in force throughout Europe. Russia is implementing a tax on exports. In such a situation, the wheat crop is less in the whole world, due to which the export price of wheat is being traded at the highest level of six years since 2014.

Egypt held a tender; they were trying to catch a gap between the previous tender and Feb 15 (Russian quota and duty), but Russian sellers include the duty to prices, so became uncompetitive- Egypt bought Ukrainian and Romanian cargoes.

The Rosario Board of Trade (BCR) forecasts total Argentinian wheat production will fall 15% on the year to 16.5 MMT, the second lowest output in a decade on extreme drought. The Buenos Aires Grain Exchange (BAGE) predicts production will total 16.9 MMT and USDA pegs the 2020/21 harvest at 18.0 MMT.

FranceAgriMer, France's agriculture office, reported the country's winter wheat farmers made considerable progress last week, 66% of France's soft (non-durum) wheat is now in the ground, up from last week's 45% and in line with the five-year average.

Ukraine As of Dec. 16. total Ukrainian grain exports are down 14% from this time last year at 23.8 MMT. 12.2 MMT of which is wheat. In October. Ukraine implemented a 17.5 MMT wheat export quota for the 2020/21 marketing year and current sales account for 70% of the quota.

US wheat futures edged higher on Tuesday, as prices rebounded from a 3% decline marked in the previous session,
