

## Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

As per trade sources, India has exported around 1.54 lakh tonnes in the month of December-2020 at an average FOB of \$238.06 per tonnes, higher this year and the major destinations were Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Nepal and Malaysia. Exports are likely to be at higher side as other countries are providing wheat at higher prices. High export will going to support the domestic market in near term.

As per trade sources, Prices of mill-quality Wheat in Kota fell today as demand from bulk buyers weakened, traders said. Arrivals were pegged at 5,000 bags (1 bag = 100 kg), up 1,000 bags from Tuesday. Prices in Jaipur too fell due to weak demand and steady supply, traders said. Arrivals were pegged at 1,500 bags (1 bag = 100 kg).

The US Department of Agriculture (USDA) on Tuesday upped its forecast of Indian wheat exports for 2020-21 (July-June) to 1.8 million tonnes (MMT), as against its earlier estimate of one MMT. That would be the highest ever in the last six years.

As per market sources, wheat stock in the central pool as of 1st January'21 stood at 342.90 lakh tonnes down by 7.18% compared to last month. This quantity is lower by around 4.35% compared to last year for the same month. The government has abundant supplies this year to tackle any unexpected rise in wheat prices by selling more quantity in the open market and through high exports.

**There is a widespread export demand for Indian wheat recently.** By the end of January, if exports are taken into consideration, then the export of 1 million tonnes of wheat will be done this year. After March, the new season will start, then there is a possibility of exporting about 2 million tonnes of wheat, most of which is expected from Gujarat.

As per the latest update on 07 January 2021, the area under wheat has increased marginally by 2.59% to 335.46 lakh hectares so far in the ongoing 2020-21 Rabi season from 326.75 lakh hectares in the year-ago same period. The overall trend of Rabi sowing progress is excellent, with increased area coverage recorded due to favourable weather. Lesser area reported in states like Punjab, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Karnataka.

**Prices of wheat continued to rise in the mandis of major producing states except for** Delhi on Friday. On Lawrence Road, Delhi, mill quality wheat's price decreased by Rs 15 per quintal from 1965 to Rs 1950 per quintal, while the daily arrival was 2000 bags. There is no rain in the states of North India today, but the weather is still bad. In Hyderabad, the wheat price of Rajasthan line has been increased from Rs 2140 to Rs 2150, UP line to Rs 2100 to Rs 2060 per quintal of Punjab line, and has increased by Rs 10 to 50 per quintal. The price of mill quality wheat in Bangalore today remained steady at Rs 2155 to Rs 2255 per quintal, while in Visakhapatnam, it was Rs 2150 per quintal.

Indian traders are expected to export around 40,000 tonnes of wheat to Bangladesh at \$210-\$220 per tonnes FOB, market sources said. The exports may take place in a few days. More exports to Bangladesh are likely this financial year as prices of wheat in India have become more competitive in the past few months. Last month, Indian traders signed deals with their counterparts in Bangladesh to export around 200,000 tonnes of wheat. High export from India will give support to domestic price.

## International Market Update:

**Bangladesh's state grains buyer has issued another international tender** to purchase 50,000 tonnes of milling wheat, traders said on Monday. The deadline for submission of price offers is Jan. 25, they said. Bangladesh has issued a series of wheat tenders in past weeks. A previous tender from Bangladesh for 50,000 tonnes of wheat had closed on Jan. 4. Other tenders also for 50,000 tonnes of wheat close on Jan. 13 and Jan. 18.

**Russian wheat export prices have risen since late 2020 ahead of an upcoming wheat** export tax, analysts at the IKAR consultancy said on Monday. One of the world's largest wheat exporters, Russia aims to stabilise food prices with a grain export quota and a wheat export tax from Feb. 15 to June 30. Wheat with 12.5% protein loading from Black Sea ports for supply before mid-February was at \$275 a tonne on a free-on-board (FOB) basis at the end of last week, up \$13 from the end of 2020, IKAR said in a note.

**SovEcon has further slashed its 2020-21 Russian wheat export forecast,** which could mean rising prices. The Russian agriculture consultancy firm is now predicting 36.3 million tonnes of exports, down from its November forecast of 40.8 million tonnes. That is well below the U.S. Department of Agriculture's December estimate of 40 million tonnes. SovEcon's drastic reduction is in response to Russia's announcement that it is imposing an export tax of 25 euros (US\$30.63) per tonne on Russian wheat between February 15 and June 30. SovEcon initially thought the tax would slice exports by two
