

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

According to Punjab Mandi Board (PMB) records, the state and government agencies have purchased 129.63 lakh metric tonnes (lakh MT) wheat from Punjab's mandis till May 11 this year. On Tuesday, 60,000 tonnes of wheat had arrived across the state's mandis, with the arrival of the crop likely to continue for the next few days. Over this record procurement, it may cross the 13 million tonnes procurement target set for this year.

According to a release from the FCI, the government has set the auction of good-quality wheat procured in 2021-22 marketing season at Rupees 21,500/mt (\$293/mt). In the 2020-21 marketing season, the government sold wheat slightly lower than the current prices, at Rupees 21,350/mt. The hike in fair-quality wheat is seen pushing up export prices of the grain, as most traders will turn to these auctions to purchase while most benchmark markets are shut due to COVID-19 related restrictions.

After procuring around 81 lakh MT wheat, government procurement agencies in Haryana have stopped the procurement operations in all 394 mandis. Expecting bumper produce this year, the government had increased the procurement target to 80 lakh MT against 74 lakh MT of last year. But the government figures revealed that around 83.50 lakh MT wheat arrived in mandis, and approximately 2.72 lakh MT is still lying unprocured.

According to Government, total wheat procurement has reached 337.95 lakh tonne until May 9 of the 2021-22 rabi marketing season (April-March), up from 220 lakh tonne year-ago period. About 34.08 lakh farmers have already benefited from the ongoing rabi marketing season, procurement operations with MSP value of Rs 63,924.56 crore,' the ministry added. Procurement of wheat -- the main rabi (winter) crop -- is continuing smoothly in Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand, Chandigarh, Himachal Pradesh, Delhi, Gujarat, Jammu & Kashmir, and Bihar.

Punjab, the highest contributor of wheat to the Central pool over the years (barring 2020), has already purchased 95% of its total expected procurement of 13 million tonnes (130 lakh metric tonnes) of the crop in just 26 days this year till May 5, data released by the state government showed. This, the data further shows, is 7% more than the procurement made last year in the same number of days. The Centre on Monday said wheat procurement rose over 70 per cent to 292.52 lakh tonnes so far in the ongoing 2021-22 rabi marketing season, benefitting about 28.80 lakh farmers.

The Haryana government has decided to stop the procurement of wheat in all mandis/procurement centres in view of the lockdown in the state from May 3-9 to check exponential surge in Covid-19 cases. "During lockdown, no procurement of wheat will be initiated in any mandis/procurement centres of the state and no gate pass shall be issued (to the farmers) for the same, an official statement said here on Sunday.

The Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY) which was announced in 2020 for three months till July, is being re-implemented given the worsening situation due to the second wave of Covid-19. Govt. will provide 5-kg additional food grains for free to PDS beneficiaries under the PMGKAY for two months -- May and June. This time, they are not providing pulses under this scheme. The government has procured 258.74 lakh tonnes of wheat till 28 April 2021 so far.

As per trade sources, India has exported around 3.98 lakh tonnes Wheat in the month of March-2021 at an average FOB of \$269 per tonnes, higher from previous month and the major destinations were Bangladesh, Malaysia, Oman, Qatar and Nepal. Exports are likely to be at higher side as other countries are providing wheat at higher prices. High export will be going to support the domestic market in near term.

Amid the second wave of Covid-19 and localized lockdown announced by some states have requested the Centre to consider releasing free food grains, similar to last year. if the government allocates wheat this year also then prices may move beneath from current level.

Haryana Government on Monday halted the wheat procurement process in 18 mandis of six districts of the state as these were full of procured wheat which was yet to be sent for storage, leading to a space crunch. The process in these mandis will remain suspended for the next 24 hours, as arrangements are being made to set up additional procurement centres. The state government has instructed farmers not to bring their crop to mandis till these centres are functional.

International Market Update:

Russian wheat export prices rose in the first 10 days of May, supported by higher prices in Chicago and Paris on corn supply concerns and despite low market activity during Russia's May 1-10 official holiday, analysts said on Tuesday. Russian wheat with 12.5% protein loading from Black Sea ports for supply in June was at \$278 a tonne free on board
