



### Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

The agriculture ministry's fourth advance estimate suggests wheat output has reached a record of 109.52 million tonnes in 2020-21, 9.10 million tonnes higher than the average production estimates of 100.42 million tonnes over the previous five years. It has increased by 1.53% from 107.86 from last year record amid good monsoon rain last year. India's food grain production is projected to rise by 3.74 percent to a new high of 308.65 million tonnes in the crop year 2020-21 compared to 297.5 million tonnes in 2019-20 due to good monsoon rains last year.

In the month of Jul'21, India export value for wheat reached 4.72 lakh tonnes higher against 4.10 lakh tonnes in June 2021. Indian wheat export volume has also increased in Jul month despite higher FOB price. In 2020-21 fiscal year, the country exported total 20.80 lakh tonnes.

Wheat procurement for the Rabi marketing season 2021-22 is completed in India's various states. Wheat was procured in excess of 433.44 LMT, a record high compared to 389.93 LMT in previous seasons. Total 49.20 lakh farmers have been benefitted with MSP value of Rs.85,603.57 crore. This season's procurement volume is also higher than the previous four years record. This Rabi season, Punjab government procured 132.10 LMT of wheat, higher from MP's procurement record of 128.08 LMT in 2021-22. However, it was procured lower at 127.14 LMT from Punjab compared to 129.42 LMT in MP during 2020-21.

Wheat exports from India have increased sharply as the global supplies are affected due to lower production in Russia, Canada and USA. In India the export of wheat during this fiscal year is expected to be somewhere around 2.5 million to 3 million due to higher demand of Indian wheat and this is higher compared to 2.08 million tons last year valued at Rs 4033.81 crore. So far India has exported 1.5 million tons of wheat. Bangladesh, Nepal, UAE, Sri lanka, Indonesia are considered to be big buyers of Indian wheat.

## **International Market Update:**

**Drought in Canada has impacted the wheat production to a 14 year low.** The estimated value of wheat production this year stood at 22.9 million tons, down 35% from last year and slightly larger than average trade expectation of 22.6 million tons.

Widespread rain in the major part of Argentina during the last 24 hours brought a great relief for the farmers ahead of 2021/22 harvest improving production prospects after a drier than normal winter. In 70% of farming area in Central region received 30 to 50 mm of rainfall. The Rosario grains exchange last week has cut down the estimate of wheat production to 20.1 million tones.

Russian agricultural consultancy has reduced the forecast of Russia's 2021 wheat crop to 75.4 million tonnes from 76.2 million tonnes due to low spring wheat yields. The yield impact is due to climatic factors where both Volga and Ural region received only 50-80% of normal rainfall in past three months along with 3-5 degree more temperature than the normal.

The CBOT trend suggest that the wheat price attempted to break 717.00 level but is fluctuating above it and facing negative pressure with a chance of breaking the mentioned level. The bearish trend will continue unless the price breach 741.90 mark and hold above it.

The wheat buyers in Asia are struggling to keep the supplies as the farmers in top exporting countries are holding back sales following production cuts which has made global wheat price reach multi year highs. The wheat processing in the current year is expected to decrease by 10%. Generally Asian countries pay much more price often due to long distance from major market which adds to delivery costs. Currently they are paying \$35 per tonne more in shipping cost from Canada.

<u>Weather Outlook:</u> Rainfall activity over Central & East India is likely to increase from 05<sup>th</sup> September with fairly widespread rainfall and isolated heavy falls over Odisha during 04<sup>th</sup>-07<sup>th</sup>, Chhattisgarh during 03<sup>rd</sup>-07<sup>th</sup>, East Madhya Pradesh during 05<sup>th</sup>-07<sup>th</sup> and West Madhya Pradesh during 06<sup>th</sup> and 07<sup>th</sup> September.
