

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

The agriculture ministry's fourth advance estimate suggests wheat output has reached a record of 109.52 million tonnes in 2020-21, 9.10 million tonnes higher than the average production estimates of 100.42 million tonnes over the previous five years. It has increased by 1.53% from 107.86 from last year record amid good monsoon rain last year. India's food grain production is projected to rise by 3.74 percent to a new high of 308.65 million tonnes in the crop year 2020-21 compared to 297.5 million tonnes in 2019-20 due to good monsoon rains last year.

In the month of Jul'21, India export value for wheat reached 4.72 lakh tonnes higher against 4.10 lakh tonnes in June 2021. Indian wheat export volume has also increased in Jul month despite higher FOB price. In 2020-21 fiscal year, the country exported total 20.80 lakh tonnes.

Wheat procurement for the Rabi marketing season 2021-22 is completed in India's various states. Wheat was procured in excess of 433.44 LMT, a record high compared to 389.93 LMT in previous seasons. Total 49.20 lakh farmers have been benefitted with MSP value of Rs.85,603.57 crore. This season's procurement volume is also higher than the previous four years record.

The government has hiked the minimum support price for wheat by Rs 40 from Rs 1975 to Rs 2015 per quintal. According to officials, CCEA has approved increase in MSP's of six rabi crops for 2021-22 crop year (July-June) and 2022-2023 marketing year. The cost of production of wheat is estimated at Rs 1008 per quintal. The expected returns to farmers over their cost of production are estimated to be highest for wheat and mustard.

Wheat exports from India have increased sharply as the global supplies are affected due to lower production in Russia, Canada and USA. In India the export of wheat during this fiscal year is expected to be somewhere around 2.5 million to 3 million due to higher demand of Indian wheat and this is higher compared to 2.08 million tons last year valued at Rs 4033.81 crore. So far India has exported 1.5 million tons of wheat. Bangladesh, Nepal, UAE, Sri lanka, Indonesia are considered to be big buyers of Indian wheat.

International Market Update:

The most active wheat future on CBOT were down by 0.1% at \$6.91-1/2 a bushel, near a session low of \$6.90-3/4 a bushel the weakest since July 29. Wheat closed down 2.4% on Thursday. U.S. wheat futures edged lower to hit a six week low as expectations of ample global supplies pushed the grains towards a weekly loss of nearly 5%.

The Turkish government has decided to lift the import duties on wheat will subject to 0pc import duty till December 31 from 17.3-130pc previously applied. Russia and Ukraine are the major exporters of wheat to Turkey but were held back in the black sea congestion due to ongoing construction work around strait of Gallipoli.

French soft wheat shipment outside EU has been the highest in three years as the export to Algeria has taken the pace after a slow start in July.

Saudi Arabia's main state wheat buying agency (SAGO) has issued and international tender of 360,000 tonnes of milling wheat for purchase. They lowered the test weight requirement to 76 which would help European wheat in France and elsewhere which was damaged by late harvest rain.

Irregular weather in Canada and Europe is resulting in the spike of price of raw materials which along with increase in freight prices is spiralling the durum wheat market completely out of control. The price of durum has skyrocketed by approx 90% due to poor weather that has affected the quality and yield of wheat.

The US Gulf Coast grain export facilities are still undergoing the aftermath of hurricane Ida which has badly affected the shipment pace of the country. Report suggests around a dozen terminal still closed yesterday due to power outrages.

<u>Weather Outlook:</u> Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated heavy to very heavy falls likely over Konkan & Goa, Odisha and Chhattisgarh during 12th-14th September. Isolated extremely heavy falls also likely over Odisha on 13th and Konkan & Goa during 13th-14th September. Scattered to fairly widespread rainfall likely to continue over Peninsular India during next 5 days.
