

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

As per sources, 56,065 MT of wheat vessel BULK BEQUIA is loading at Kandla Port since 20th October 2021. And 5,500 MT of wheat vessel PENEY loading at Kandla Port since 20th October 2021. And 54,000 MT of wheat vessel MEGHNA ENERGY is loading at Kandla Port since 26th October 2021. Also, 54,600 MT of wheat vessel MANDARIN CROWN is loading at Kandla since 26th October 2021. Also, 55,000 MT of wheat vessel MERIDA is loading at Kandla Port since 25th October 2021. And 51,000 MT of wheat vessel OCEAN REEF is loading at Kandla Port since 28th October 2021. And 31,000 MT of wheat vessel EAST AYUTTHAYA is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 23rd October 2021. And 33,000 MT of wheat vessel PACIFIC ISLAND is loading a Kandla Port since 28th October 2021. Also, 54,000 MT of wheat vessel ORCHID is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 28th October 2021.

As per Agriwatch sources, 1.85 lakh tonnes of wheat were exported from India during the month of September 2021 at an average FOB of \$323.66 per tonne. It is 59 percent lower compared to August with export of 4.51 lakh tonnes. This is due to the container shortages and more waiting time observed in various ports during the month of September. Bangladesh continues to be the largest importer of Indian wheat with 1.41 lakh tonnes 64 percent lower compared to previous month export of 3.89 lakh tonnes. Srilanka and Nepal are the second and third largest importers with 0.16 lakh tonnes and 0.15 lakh tonnes.

The price of mill delivery in Kanpur was not trading as the market was closed. While in Lawrence Road the wheat was up by Rs.20 and traded at Rs. 2190 per quintal. While in Indore and Khanna the price of wheat was not trading as themarket was closed.

Most of the farmers in Haryana are shifting to Mustard from Wheat as the prices of mustard saw a skyrocketing price compared to previous year and also the input cost for mustard is very low compared to wheat.

International Market Update:

On Tuesday, Chicago wheat rose to trade a nine year high due to declining condition of US winter wheat which is raising concerns over global supply. The most active wheat contract on CBOT was up 0.3% at \$7.99 per bushel.

As per recent studies wheat could expand to higher latitudes by 2030 increasing its global yield, if the global warming trend continues. It is expected that wheat yield would increase by 17 percent by 2030.

Ukraine's wheat export rose to 16 percent on the year to 12.4 million MT since the start of 2021-22 marketing year on July 1 to November 1.

As per the reports by NASS of USDA, the total whole wheat flour production in USA in July-September was **4.97** million cwts, up 66,000 cwts or 1.3% from 4.90 cwts in the third quarter of 2020. The quarterly total was up 2.2% from 4.87 million cwts in second quarter.

Wheat prices have surged from US to Russia and hitting a record in Europe and raising bread cost all over the world. Wheat in Chicago traded lower on Tuesday after trading highest on Monday since December 2012 while Paris futures reached a record 297 euros before closing at 292.75 euros.

Russian wheat export prices further gained last week due to higher prices for wheat in Chicago and Paris ad higher demand from Egypt. CBOT is the benchmark for the Russian market has reached eight-year highs. Russian wheat with 12.5% protein supplied from Black Sea ports in the first half of November was at FOB \$317 per tonne up 5% from last week.

Japan is seeking to buy a total of 143,396 tonnes of food quality wheat from US, Canada and Australia in a regular tender.

<u>Weather Outlook</u>- Isolated heavy rainfall is also very likely over Telangana and Lakshadweep on 03rd November, Rayalseema during 03rd-05th November, over Odisha on 03rd November, over coastal and south interior Karnataka during 04th & 05th November; overnorth Karnataka on 05th November and over South Konkan and Goa on 05th, 06th &07th November, 2021.
