

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

As per sources, 59,500 MT of wheat vessel INCE KASTAMONU is loading at Kandla Port since 15th November 2021. Also, 54,000 MT of wheat vessel MEGHNA ROSE is loading at Kandla Port since 15th November 2021. Also, 58,800 MT of wheat vessel BULK CASTOR is loading at Kandla Port since 18th November 2021. And, 6,000 MT of wheat vessel ABDULLATIF is waiting for loading at Kandla Port since 20th November 2021. Also, 61,510 MT of wheat vessel KIRAN ISTANBUL is expected to arrive at Kandla Ports on 22nd November 2021. And 54,500 MT of wheat vessel PRABHU MIHIKAA is expected to arrive at Kandla Port on 22nd November 2021.

As per Agriwatch sources, 1.86 lakh tonnes of wheat were exported from India during the month of October 2021 at an average FOB of \$322.21 per tonne. It is 0.45 percent higher compared to September with export of 1.85 lakh tonnes. Bangladesh continues to be the largest importer of Indian wheat with 1.43 lakh tonnes 1.42 percent higher compared to previous month export of 1.41 lakh tonnes. Nepal is the second largest importer with 0.09 lakh tonnes of imports and Srilanka being the third largest importer with 0.04 lakh tonnes.

As on 19th November, around 88.460 lakh hectares of wheat has been sown higher by 7.753 lakh hectares against 80.707 lakh hectares the previous year.

International Market Update:

Ukraine's wheat export prices rose by nearly 9 percent over past month. Ukraine's wheat with 11.5% protein was at FOB \$339.25 per tonne on November 22nd up by \$ 1.25 from November 19th. The export prices are expected to rise again as Middle Eastern countries are moving away from Russia to purchase the food grains.

Russian wheat prices gained for 5th consecutive week due to strong demand from importers. Russia exported around 250,000 tonnes of wheat Algeria which is dominated by French market. Russian wheat with 12.5% protein loading from Black Sea region for supply in first week of December was \$337 per tonne FOB at the end of last week.

Britain's wheat is expected to be higher for 2022 harvest as the planting conditions were favorable and higher prices supported farmers to sow more wheat. The wheat was sown at 1.81 million hectares up by 1.3 percent from 2021 harvest.

Bread prices rose by around 20 percent as wheat prices hit nine year high. Pasta prices have also started to rise in recent week and is expected to rise more in coming weeks as well and currently food prices are at ten years high. The wheat used for feed has also risen by around 16 percent compared to previous year.

Bangladesh's state grain buyer received lowest CIF of \$409.77 per tonne on an international tender to purchase and import 50,000 tonnes of wheat. No purchase was made yet and the offer is still being considered.

IGC on Thursday cut its forecast for 2021-22 global wheat production driven by diminished outlook for the crop in Iran. The wheat crop outlook reduced by 4 million tonnes to 777 million tonnes.

Heavy harvest rain and is causing extensive quality damage to Australian wheat crop in northern and central new south wales and Queensland due to the re-emergence of La Nina effect which is responsible for 50 to 100 millimetres of rains at an inappropriate time in those two major producing regions at first half of November. More rain is forecasted during the second half of the month.

Despite widespread flooding and debris flows in British Columbia, Canadian wheat prices remains steady after shut down of major rail and pipeline services into the province. No bids were heard for next 30-45 days forward Canadian western red spring wheat due to possibility of vessel delays and disruptions to terminal operations.

Vietnam has announced that it will eliminate 3 percent tariff on US wheat imports by the end of the year. US wheat exports are much slower this year to Vietnam due to high prices and lower supplies. Vietnam imported more than 500,000 tonnes of US wheat valued at \$129 million in marketing year 2021-22, second in volume only to Australia.

<u>Weather Outlook-</u> Light to moderate fairly widespread rainfall over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, South Interior Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal during next 5 days. Isolated heavy rainfall very likely over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe during next 5 days and over South Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Rayalaseema during 25th-27th November, 2021.
