

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

As per sources, 60,500 MT of wheat vessel NEW GALAXY is loading at Kandla Port since 13th January 2022. And 55,000 MT of wheat vessel BULK VENUS is loading at Kandla port since 12th January 2022. Also, 55,000 MT of wheat vessel NAVDHENU PURNA is loading at Kandla Port since 09th January 2022. And 60,500 MT of Wheat vessel CHRISTINA is loading at Kandla Port since 10th January 2022. And 52,500 MT of wheat vessel MEGHNA PARADISE is loading at Kandla Port since 06th January 2022.

Food ministry has approved a policy which encourage the private players to bid for construction of 249 silos with close to 11 million tonnes (MT) wheat storage capacity for the Food Corporation of India (FCI). The silos will be built across 12 states, including Punjab, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Haryana and Kerala, over the next four to five years through the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model with an estimated investment of Rs 9,200 crore.

India has exported around 8.58 lakh tonnes of wheat during the month of December 2021 at an average FOB of \$314.95 per tonne as per trade sources. Bangladesh remains the largest importer of Indian wheat with 2.90 lakh tonnes followed by Sri Lanka with 1.15 lakh tonnes of imports. The fall is mainly due to lower imports from Bangladesh and Philippines. Due to shortage of trucks and covid restrictions the exports were lower to Bangladesh while Philippines shifted the market to Australia owing to better proximity.

As on 21st January 2022, area sown to wheat fell by 1.25 percent to 340.83 lakh hectare in the current rabi season from 345.14 lakh hectare the previous year during the corresponding period. The acreage was down mainly due to acreage shift from wheat to mustard in the states of Rajasthan, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh.

International Market Update:

Algeria's move to halt imports of French wheat will create a hefty surplus stock of wheat for France and will help the rival countries to break French wheat dominance in Algeria. India's highly competitive price can help enter the Algerian market but chances of shifting from France to Argentina is more probable in case of Algeria due to better proximity and bumper production there.

As of 17th January, Ukraine's wheat exports for the Marketing Year 2021-22 were 28% higher year on year at 16.3 million metric tonnes (MMT). Wheat exports from Ukraine have gathered momentum over the past few months, as neighbouring Russia increased its export taxes. However, the pace has slowed down to some extent, with the ongoing tensions between Russia and Ukraine. The export prices remain highly uncompetitive for both Russia and Ukraine and that can be helpful for Indian wheat which still remains highly competitive.

Russia's floating export duty fell by \$1.70 per tonne from previous week and will be taxed at \$95.80 per tonne from January 21 to February 1. From Feb. 15 to the end of the Marketing Year on June 30, an additional constraint on exporters will come from the government's wheat export quota, which was announced in December at 8 MMT. The wheat export price stood at \$330 per tonne this week lower than previous week due to fall in the export duty price.

Soft wheat exports from the European Union in the 2021-22 season had reached 15.32 million tonnes as of January 16th. European Union exports have impacted as Algeria, a major market of French wheat has started shifting to other sources of wheat.

Jordan is believed to have made no purchase in an international tender to buy 120,000 tonnes of milling wheat which closed on 18th January. A new tender is expected to be issued in coming days closing on February 1.

In US, excessively warm temperatures and dry weather are impacting this year's wheat harvest in Oklahoma. Over 94% of the state is experiencing some level of drought and the state needs rain between now and April to make a difference in the wheat crop. If there is a deficit rainfall, we can see a major fall in the production which was already seen in the previous year.

<u>Weather Outlook</u>: Widespread light/moderate rainfall/snowfall accompanied with isolated thunderstorm/lightning/hailstorm very likely over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh & Uttarakhand on 22nd & 23rd and reduce thereafter to isolated/scattered rainfall/snowfall. Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall accompanied with isolated thunderstorm/lightning/hailstorm very likely over Punjab, Haryana- Chandigarh-Delhi, Uttar Pradesh on 22nd & 23rd January and reduce thereafter to isolated rainfall. Isolated Heavy rainfall likely over Punjab, Haryana and Northwest Uttar Pradesh on 22nd January.
