

### Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

**Lebanon is planning to import 50,000 tonne of wheat through an international tender from India but the timing depends on Lebanon** Central Bank's set criteria. They have asked the Central Bank to provide advance of \$26 million in order to issue a tender. Lebanon is also waiting response from USA and Kazakhstan. And 26,000 tonne of Ukrainian wheat are on its way.

The government's food subsidy costs are expected to fall by roughly Rs 26,000 crore during 2022-23 due to smaller volume of wheat procurement in the Rabi Marketing Session, which starts on April 1. The procurement is expected to be around 34 million metric tonne (MMT), as opposed to the target of 44 MMT.

As per sources, exports from other wheat-producing states, particularly Punjab and Haryana, will be difficult due to a lack of necessary transportation infrastructure, greater transportation costs to western ports, and higher grain purchase taxes.

*Currently there is lower chance of a major inflation like scenario in the Indian market as the stocks available is huge and new crop arrivals is about to come in all the major markets. But it is expected that if Indian wheat exports rise by 45-50 percent in 2022, it will push the price of wheat by 8-10 percent from a year ago in the first quarter of next Fiscal Year.* 

*In Haryana, the procurement of wheat will start from April 1st and would continue till May 15th. For the Rabi Marketing Season* 2022-23, around 398 mandis and procurement centres have been in the state for the procurement of wheat.

#### International Market Update:

As per sources, it is unlikely that Australia's next wheat crop to cross the record tonnage produced in 2021-22. According to ABARES, Australian growers are forecasted to plant 12.4 million hectares of wheat in coming months which is 5 percent below the 13.039 million hectares planted in 2021-22 producing a record 37.3 MMT of wheat which is followed by the previous record of 33.3 MMT, grown over 12.885 million hectares in 2020-21. The low wheat acreage is due to high input costs, dry weather conditions and possibility of wheat prices to reverse by the time Australia's 2022-23 harvest rolls out.

*Turkey has issued an international tender to purchase and import about 210,000 tonne of milling wheat. The deadline for submission of price offers in the wheat tender is March 23. Wheat shipment is sought between April 1-April 30.* 

Iraq is expected to produce approximately 500,000 tonne less wheat than 2021. Iraq is expected to produce 3 million tonne of wheat this year. Iraq's present wheat reserves, stored in silos, will only last three months. Iraq is working on increasing wheat production in the country to bolster its self-sufficiency and reduce its heavy reliance on imports.

*Ukraine is likely to export just 200,000 tonne of wheat from March to June due to its Black Sea ports being blocked by the Russian invasion. As per reports, 2021-22 (July-June) wheat exports would not exceed 18.3 million tonne, while ending stocks will reach 5.9 million tonne. Ukraine exported 18.1 million tonne of wheat from July 2021 to March 2022.* 

Argentina increased its annual wheat export quota for the 2022-23 season by 8 MMT from 2 MMT to a total of 10 MMT to take advantages of high international prices. Argentina limits exports of wheat in a bid to ensure domestic supply and to avoid local price hikes. But Russia's invasion of Ukraine has led to a surge in wheat prices, as both countries combined normally provided 30% of global supply of the grain. The new increased export quota remains lower than the previous 2021-2022 cycle, in which Argentina allowed exports of 14.5 million tonne of wheat. In Argentina, next wheat season will only begin when planting starts in May, but sales are often decided months in advance, especially in times of high prices.

In Russia, in the month of March, larger proportions of shipment of wheat are taking place in small cargoes reflecting difficulty in arranging insurance and shipping. Many traders with large vessels were unwilling to load from Russia. There is no more market for large cargoes as there is lack of handy-size cargoes on Russian FOB basis.

*Currently U.S. wheat prices are already high because of inflation and restricted supplies, but globally the wheat prices are driven up due* to Russia-Ukraine war and could increase the prices of wheat globally. Prices depends on type of grain but in recent days the cost of white soft wheat was \$11.70 per bushel higher compared to \$7.35 per bushel the previous year. It is expected that countries that rely on wheat exports from Ukraine could face shortages starting in July which increases food insecurity and potentially throwing more people into poverty in countries that depend on the product. In the coming year people might turn to more affordable grains and substitutes for wheat which could potentially affect wheat prices.

<u>Weather Outlook</u>: Light isolated/scattered rainfall very likely over Kerala & Mahe, Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Karnataka during next 5 days and over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Rayalaseema during next 3 days. Isolated thunderstorm/lightning activity also very likely over Kerala & Mahe during next 5 days, over Coastal & South Interior Karnataka during next 3 days and over Tamilnadu, Puducherry-Karaikal, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Rayalaseema during next 24 hours.
